

The Power of Attitude

As human beings who are imperfect and who live in an imperfect world we, in turn, are powerless over so many things. First and foremost, we are completely and ultimately powerless over other people and the personal decisions which they make. Perhaps we may even make efforts to manipulate others to do what we would like them to do. Yet, in the end, people are beyond our control. People have the prerogative to think what they will, do what they will and speak as they will. In fact this freedom is a gift from God which is known as free will.

Furthermore, we are powerless, as individuals, to change institutions and organizations. As individuals we are also powerless to change policies and procedures which other groups of individuals have created. We, as individuals, are also powerless over structures and systems which are the products of a corporate effort.

We are also, to some extent, powerless over the natural world. As individuals we can not cause the weather to be as we wish or a particular season to begin or end earlier or later. We can not control the snow or rain whether it is sunny or cloudy. We are simply powerless.

Being people of Faith we ascribe all power to God and trust that all is fundamentally well because all is in God's Hands. This disposition in us creates a beautiful spiritual foundation called Peace. With this peace we can deal with life on life's terms believing that our need is God's opportunity to work. We can accept the limitations within ourselves, in others (and even in the weather!) confident that God is with us. With such a faithful attitude life does not become perfect, life becomes acceptable, and we begin too see the goodness of God in ourselves, in others, and in our world. We even enjoy life despite all its imperfections. Attitude is everything!
