

#### Humility

There are so many different things we are called to be as Christian Catholics. There are so many different ideals that we are challenged to incorporate into our lives as we call ourselves followers of our Lord Jesus Christ. There is the virtue of charity, for example, by which and with which we are challenged to look at other people and their lives with both compassion and understanding. There is the virtue of patience that we are called to cultivate in our hearts by being sympathetic toward others and their situations and which enables us to be gentle in our dealings and conversations. Yet among the many virtues and spiritual goals that we are called to make part of our lives and relationships is one, without which, spiritual religious growth is impossible. This virtue is the virtue of humility.

However, humility does not stand on its own or exist apart from another important and vital spiritual characteristic and virtue. That characteristic and virtue is honesty. The degree to which we are honest truly determines the degree to which we will be able to make any progress at all or grow at all in spiritual health. Honestly with ourselves and about ourselves is absolutely necessary for us to change those things in our character that are hurtful or harmful to ourselves and to those with whom we live. Honestly, especially self honesty is the basic foundation upon which the companion virtue of humility must be nurtured and carefully developed. Without honesty and radical truthfulness, humility can not exist. This is due to the fact that humility is simply knowing who we are, both our strengths and our weaknesses and living accordingly. Humility is not pretending to be less than other people or pretending to be more than other people. Humility is striving to be "just right sized" according to our talents and also according to our limitations. Humility is living honestly, acting honestly, and relating honestly with one another. The virtue of humility allows us to change ourselves for the better and use our talents and strengths for the good of ourselves and for our sisters and brothers without pride or pretense. People with humility are trusted and appreciated because "what you see is what you get". In our society of competition and self aggrandizement, as God's children, let's practice humility which can only bring honest goodness into our world, and enhance the blessing of God.

#### Come be a Mountie for the Day on November 11!


