What we are learning:

Happy New Year! We hope you had an amazing Christmas break with your families and enjoyed the long vacation!

We will continue counting and practicing number recognition, writing our numbers, and practicing patterns. We will also continue "Leader of the Day" and this friend will assist with all of our classroom jobs for the day.
