
FROM THE DESK OF





Christ-centered guidance on faith development during the RCIA inquiry stage.

The RCIA inquiry stage is the starting place for adults and children 8 and older who are thinking about entering the Catholic Church. In the inquiry stage, you're just finding out about Jesus, Christianity, and the Catholic Church. Talk to people, walk around in our shoes for a bit and get a feel for the place. As an inquirer, you may not yet be sure exactly what you think about the Catholic Church. You want more information. You want to ask questions. Your main task here is to develop your faith a little bit. Get to know Christ, prayer, the Catholic Church, and how Christians live. That's the only way you can make an informed decision about entering the Catholic Church.

Let's put it more simply: you need to desire to fall in love with Jesus.
