- 2. Fill it up with refundable cans or bottles.
- 3. Drop it off at any **BottleDrop** location using the exterior bag drop door by scanning the code on the bag to open the door and throw the whole bag in.

In addition, the 1st Wednesday of every month will be a school **BottleDrop** bag drop day, just drop your filled **BLUE** bags at the entrance of the school by 3:15pm and PTO will bring them to **BottleDrop** for you.
