A teacher/parishioner's perspective about the Capital Campaign:

I started attending Holy Family Church when I moved to the neighborhood in 2014. As a young adult, I dabbled between multiple parishes, but always felt welcome at Holy Family. My goddaughter was baptized here, and I fell in love with the small, close-knit community. I got to know several of the teachers (Mrs. Massini, Mrs. DeFrancia, Mrs. Cochran) through archdiocesan teacher workdays, and decided I really wanted to teach at Holy Family someday. I became a parishioner, our wedding was blessed at Holy Family during Covid, and my daughter was baptized here.

This is my third-year teaching Middle School at Holy Family. I was privileged to work with "the greats" like Mrs. Dickinson and Mrs. Richard, and deeply feel that it's my vocation to continue the legacy they began.

Those of you who have gotten to know me understand how passionate I am about the needs of Holy Family, and our dreams and desired funding to continue to build us up and maintain a competitive, marketable status in our community; we want a top-notch educational program focused on the Catholic faith, built with a strong partnership between parents and teachers.

However, I also believe in this Capital Campaign. What's good for the parish IS good for the school – and vice versa. ADA accessibility would be wonderful, especially as we restart traditions like Circle of Life and strengthen our Prayer Partner program.

A new HVAC system would be a dream come true - it is incredibly hard to teach when students and teachers are uncomfortable.








THURSDAY, MARCH 21ST Middle School Science Fair






