





• Three mornings a week, we gathered as a school to pray and • Second - eighth grades participated in a Reconciliation Service.


Please join us this Good Friday as we end Lent on holy note by witnessing the Living Stations of the Cross led by 5th grade at 2:15pm in Church.



Volunteer & Service Opportunities

Holy Family's tuition does not cover the full cost of educating students. Families are required to provide additional support through the Fair Share program to the school/parish community. Fair Share Program is a mandatory family participation program in which each family contributes 25 hours of service to the school and/or parish, or pays a buy-out fee of \$625. The purpose of the Fair Share Program is to keep tuition costs down and to increase family
