Summaries for Altar Society Committees

Altar Flowers - Per committee schedule - order flowers for altar each week and move them to foyer after weekend.

Altar Linens, Purificators, Priest Vestments - Wash, iron and repair altar linens, purificators and priests' vestments.

Bake Sale - Everyone is asked to bake items for bake sales held two-to-three times a year. Talk to the chairman if you would like to help sell after the masses.

Bunco Party - Help prepare food, set up tables and clean up after quarterly game hosted by Holy Family in January.

Candelabras - Set up and take down candelabras for weddings and special occasions, Easter and Christmas.

<u>Christmas Decorations</u> - Help set up decorations after the 11:00 a.m. mass in December and take down in January. A variety of areas to help with – window decorations, Christmas trees, Nativity scenes (Sanctuary main altar and day chapel), candelabras and poinsettias.

<u>Coffee & Donuts</u> - Help set up, serve donuts, coffee, orange juice or milk, and clean up after the 7:30 & 9:00 a.m. masses on first Sunday of every third month (alternate with Catholic Daughters and KC's). (This committee serves October to October.)

Easter Decorations - Order, set up, water and remove lilies for Easter or set up and take down window decorations.

First Communion Reception - Help set up, serve food, and clean up at reception for First Communicants and their families.

<u>Games Party</u> - Help set up tables, serve food, drinks, and desserts. Clean up during and after games party. Many different areas to help with – kitchen, tables/chairs/reservations, silent auction, raffle, tickets and door prizes.

<u>Graduation Brunch Reception</u> - Help set up & serve graduating seniors & their families the 3rd Sunday of May after 9:00 a.m. or 11:00 a.m. mass.

Holy Water Fonts - Keep sponges and fonts clean and filled with Holy Water.

Lenten Altar Scene - Set up and take down altar scene for Lent on Sanctuary main altar

Lenten Mini-Retreat - Plan, register guests, serve food and clean up at retreat held Saturday before Lent.

<u>May Crowning</u> - Set up, then move flowers from altar and place in chapel or foyer. Need to remove dead flowers, keep clean water on the flowers, then take down flowers and statue of Mary in May.

Plants - Water and care for plants in church and foyer.

Prayer Garden - Weed and maintain plants when needed.

<u>Server Vestments</u> - Wash, iron and repair short white server vestments during the year. Long black robes are washed once a year (not pressed), and sometimes long white robes need to be washed. Members of this committee take turns.

Sew & Sew - Quilt, sew and piece items for the church festival auction.

<u>Social Committee</u> - Plan, set up, decorate, and take down for four social events during the year. This committee works with the hostesses for the months these socials occur.

Telephone Committee - Call members (on your list) approximately six times a year to remind them of upcoming events.

(This committee serves October to October.)

<u>Visiting Sick</u> - Go to hospital you are assigned to and visit sick members of the society, their immediate family living at home, parishioners and others as recommended by the parish priest.

<u>Wedding Anniversary Reception</u> - Help set up, serve and clean up at reception held each February to honor parish couples celebrating wedding anniversaries.
