Catholic identity is at our foundation, and we strive to integrate faith into our daily lessons. Students bring it beyond the classroom by celebrating weekly mass, preparing for the sacraments, and participating in works of service. Each grade plans and leads at least one mass for the entire school each week, and we join the community by opening our church for the Chaplet of Divine Mercy each Friday.

PRICELESS EDUCATION, AFFORDABLE TUITION

Our goal is to keep Holy Spirit Catholic School affordable. In addition to minimal annual tuition increases, Holy Spirit offers Scrip to help offset the cost of educating your children. Scrip allows you to purchase gift cards for everyday businesses, and you get a portion to use toward tuition. Furthermore, take advantage of our discount for families with three or more students enrolled here, as well as tuition referral bonuses for new families.

How we compare:

- Our all-Inclusive care rate: about \$3.46 per hour
- K-8th grade tuition: about \$2.33 per hour
- Average traditional childcare: \$3.80 per hour

MEETING INDIVIDUAL NEEDS

Some students just need a little extra help. To aid those children, we staff a resource educator who works with their parents and the classroom teacher to come up with a *Success Contract*. The contract helps keep students accountable to achieving their goals. Special instruction could be within the classroom, as well as working with students one-on-one to help meet their individual needs.

TECHNOLOGY THAT EXCELS

Because technology is ever-evolving, we incorporate it throughout our school in various ways. Many classrooms are equipped with interactive whiteboards, projectors, and document cameras. Students participate in a technology class starting in 4K and continue through grade 8. Students in Kindergarten and First Grade share a classroom set of iPads to help enhance their learning and provide extra practice on skills taught in the classroom. Students in Grades 2 - 8 have one-to-one technology: Depending on their age, each student has their own tablet to use in the classroom, or their own Chromebook to collaborate throughout the day as needed.

SAFETY IS A PRIORITY

Students' social and emotional wellbeing is a primary concern. We've adopted cameras at entrances and throughout our building, shatter-resistant film on windows, panic buttons, and zero-entry without a key or allowance through our office entrance. As you would expect, we routinely have fire, tornado, and intruder drills. Every staff member and volunteer is required to be trained in the diocesan VIRTUS-Protecting God's Children program, which includes a complete criminal background check.
