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# Principal's Report

February 18, 2020

#### 1. Curriculum update

- a. We are NOT going to purchase Wilson Language Phonics program: 'Fundations' for K-grade 2. Too time consuming for what we were looking for. We will continue to figure out what program will best fit our needs.
- b. We did purchase several phonological awareness materials, other early literacy materials for our 4K-grade 2 and resource teachers to help students in the beginning stages of reading.

### 2. Choice update

a. Mike and Joan will be attending a DPI in person training on March 6 to discuss budgets, audits, etc. WPCP/Affordable Education info session is set for February 20 at 6:00 pm. Plan is to have a 15-20 presentation, Q&A, then allow parents to either register for Holy Spirit or the WPCP in the computer lab.
