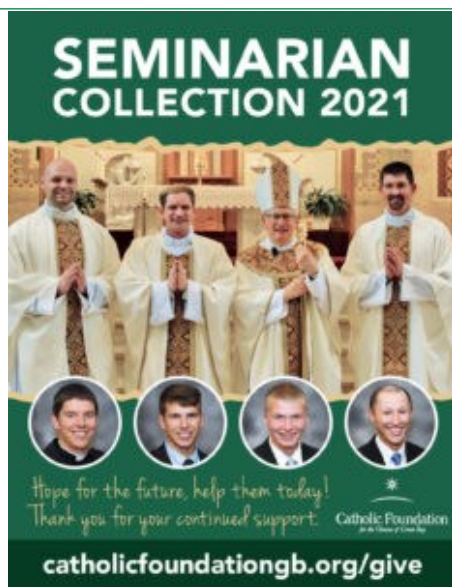
SEMINARIAN COLLECTION

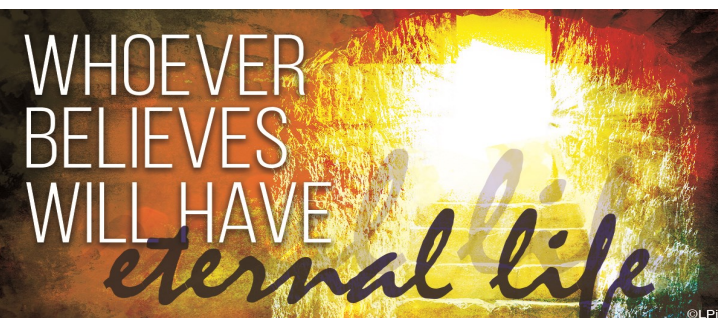


GREATER FOX CITIES AREA HABITAT FOR HUMANITY

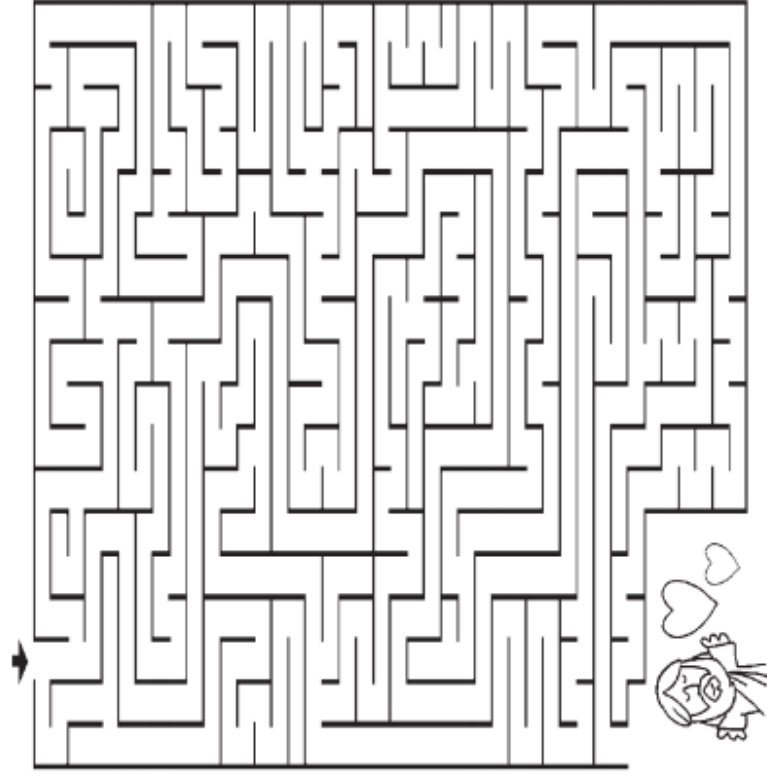
