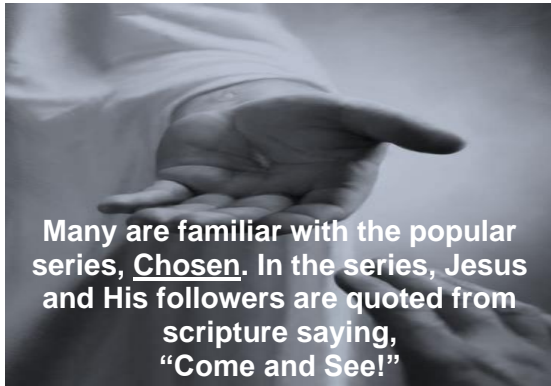

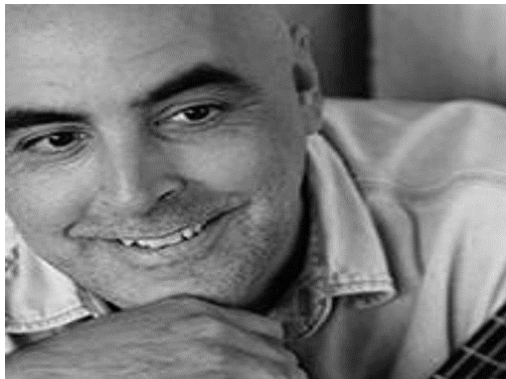


Many are familiar with the popular series, Chosen. In the series, Jesus and His followers are quoted from scripture saying, "Come and See!"

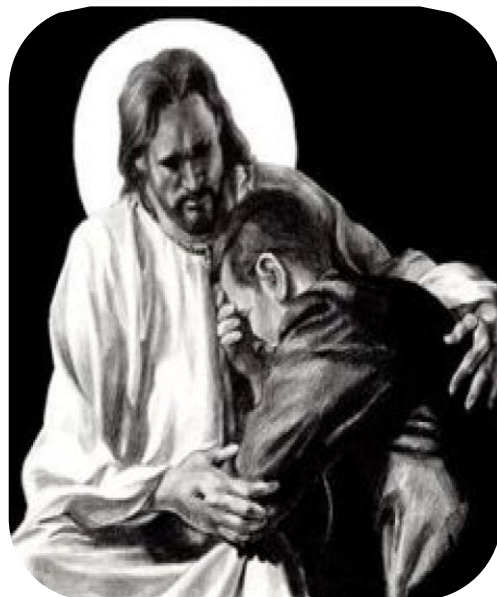

Do you BELIEVE it is the true body and blood of Christ as our faith teaches us?

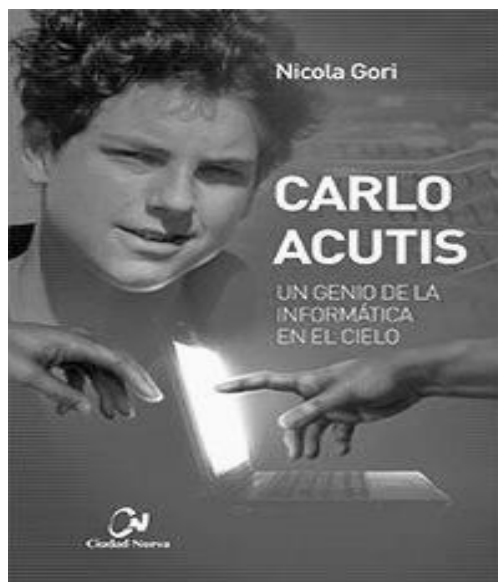

“Blessed Carlo Acutis (3 May 1991 – 12 October 2006) was an English-born Italian Catholic youth and amateur computer programmer,^[3] who is best known for documenting Eucharistic miracles around the world and cataloguing them onto a website which he created before his death from leukemia.^[3] He was noted for his cheerfulness, computer skills, and deep devotion to the Eucharist, which became a core theme of his life.^[4] He was beatified on 10 October 2020, two days before the 14th anniversary of his death.”
