This report was made in 1992. While preparing the Eucharistic reserve, a Eucharistic minister found some pieces of consecrated Host on the corporal, as the Church prescribes in these situations, the priest had them put in a vessel of water, which was then placed in the tabernacle to wait for them to dissolve. On Friday, May 8, the priests opened the tabernacle and saw that the Host fragments had become a reddish color that looked like blood. Additionally, on August 15, 1996, during the Mass of the Assumption of the Most Holy Virgin, a second consecrated Host, which fell to the ground during the distribution of Communion, was placed again in a vessel of water so it would dissolve. A few days later, the tabernacle was reopened, and it was observed that the Host was not dissolved and showed several reddish stains that became larger each day. The priests of the parish reported to Archbishop of Buenos Aires what had happened. In 1999, after the Archbishop was made aware of the fact that Professor Ricardo Castanon was performing these types of scientific investigations, he asked him to take up the case. On October 6, 1999, the professor went to Buenos Aires and interviewed the 5 priests who witnessed the event who also told him about the event in 1992. The priests, in the first miracle, had asked one of their lady parishioners who was a chemist to analyze the bleeding Host. She discovered that it was human blood and that it presented the entire leukocyte formula. She observed that the white blood cells were active. The professor brought a sample from the two bleeding Hosts before the archiepiscopal. On October 21, 1999 they found some fragments of human DNA in the samples, it was human blood that contained the human genetic code. In March of 2000 legal histopathologist, Dr. Robert Lawrence, joined in this analysis because in the samples they had found some substances which resembled human tissues.

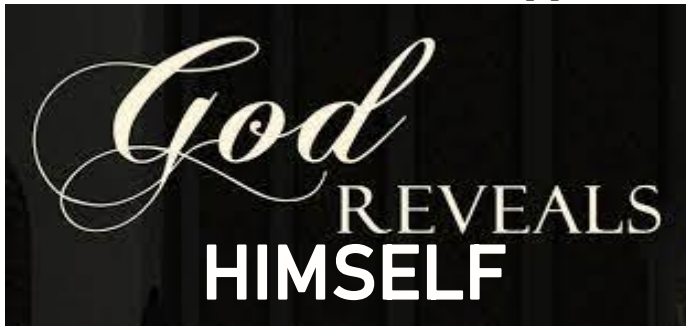
