

Safe Environment protocols were put into place after the creation in 2002 of the USCCB's Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People.

In accordance with the charter, the Archdiocese of Oklahoma City created policies and protocols for all churches and schools that addressed precautions for preventing child abuse, training to recognize abuse of children and vulnerable adults and how to report suspected or known abuse. Over the years, the program has grown to include important topics such as human trafficking, technology safety, and suicide prevention.

The protocol in the archdiocese and Oklahoma state law have made all adults mandatory reporters of known or suspected abuse. If someone suspects abuse of a child in a church setting, school, families, sports, or any other environment, they must call the state Department of Human Services or law enforcement immediately. If the suspected abuse involves Church personnel or volunteers, contact the Archdiocesan Abuse Hotline at (405)720-9878 to speak to a licensed counselor.

To become a volunteer at St Andrew's, contact Ann Grover, the St Andrew's safe environment facilitator, and she will provide instructions on becoming a volunteer and accessing the Safe and Sacred training portal.

The requirements to become a volunteer include creating a user account in the Safe and Sacred system, submitting a criminal background check, submitting three references to the parish safe environment facilitator to be checked, submitting and adhering to all safe environment polies and completing a safe environment training course in the Safe and Sacred training portal.

Training is required annually.

Background check renewals will occur every three years and are aligned with the training cycle. When a user is required to renew their background check, the system will automatically direct them to ISP (Integrated Screening Partners) to complete the renewal process when they log into the system. After completing the background check, the user will need to complete their annual training.

The Safe and Sacred system will automatically send a reminder email to all existing users advising them of the need to renew their training. Please check your junk/spam box for this email from "Tech Support" if you don't see the email in your inbox.


