

The application and scheduling of the Ball field shall be on a first come first served basis with scheduling beginning at 9am on February 1st and July 1st. of each year. Priority is given to User(s) who are supporting members of St. Andrew's, allowing these User(s) to apply February 1st There is **NO AUTOMATIC** and July 1st. **RENEWAL** from season to season or year to year. Deadline for registration February 25th and July 25th for each year.

*****Each team will pay \$100 for active parishioners) and \$200 for those who are non-contributors) to our parish user fee per season, for the maintenance and upkeep of the fields. This fee will be required, when signed application is turned into St. Andrew's representative.

*****Each team is required to submit a valid Certificate of Insurance naming St Andrew Catholic Church and the Archdiocese of Oklahoma City as ADDITIONAL INSURED in the amount of \$100,000.
