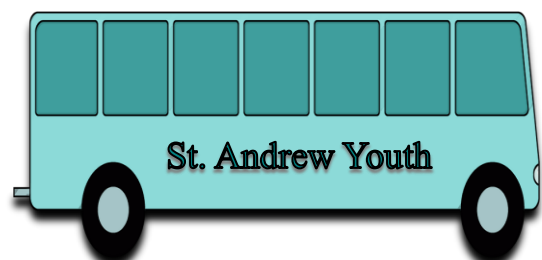

Priority is given to User(s) who are supporting members of St. Andrew's, allowing these User(s) to apply February 1st and July 1st. There is **NO AUTOMATIC RENEWAL** from season to season or year to year. Deadline for registration February 25th and July 25th for each year.

*****Each team will pay **\$100 for active parishioners** and **\$200 for those who are non-contributors** to our parish user fee per season, for the maintenance and upkeep of the fields. This fee will be required, when signed application is turned into St. Andrew's representative.

*****Each team is required to submit a valid Certificate of Insurance naming St Andrew Catholic Church and the Archdiocese of Oklahoma City as **ADDITIONAL INSURED** in the amount of \$100,000.
