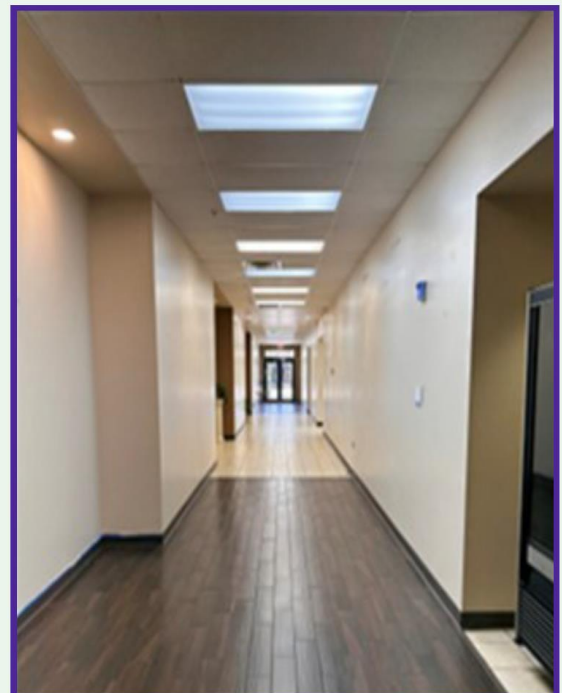

SAFE ENVIRONMENT RENEWAL TRAINING

All Archdiocesan Personnel, clergy, seminarians, religious, employees and volunteers, are required to protect the rights of children and be alert to the possibility for child abuse.

Under Oklahoma State law, all individuals MUST report an incident or suspicion of sexual abuse of a minor (person under 18 years of age) to the civil authorities.

To become a volunteer at St Andrew's, contact Ann Grover at agrover@standrewmoore.com, the St Andrew's safe environment facilitator, and she will provide instructions on becoming a volunteer and accessing the training portal. All employees and all volunteers who work with youth or vulnerable adults must be compliant in the archdiocesan safe environment system.

The requirements to become a volunteer include creating a user account in the Safe and Sacred system, submitting a criminal background check, submitting three references to the parish safe environment facilitator to be checked, submitting, and adhering to all safe environment policies and completing a safe environment training course in the Safe and Sacred training portal.

Training is required annually and expires on July 31st. Training must be renewed by August 30th to stay compliant in the system. Background check renewals will occur every three years and are aligned with the training cycle. When a user is required to renew their background check, the system will automatically direct them to ISP (Integrated Screening Partners) to complete the renewal process when they log into the system. After completing the background check, the user will need to complete their annual training.

The Safe and Sacred system automatically sends a reminder email to all existing users advising them of the need to renew their training. Please check your junk/spam box for this email from "Tech Support" if you don't see the email in your inbox. If you believe you are in the system and didn't receive an email, contact Ann Grover and she will give you the link and user id to renew your training.
