Thank You, Lord For 50 Years of Priestly Service

Fifty years......where did it all begin? I was serving as a Deacon Associate at St. Philip Neri in the Summer of 1973 when I learned that Archbishop John Quinn would ordain me to the priesthood on August 23rd. It had been a long uphill journey since entering seminary in 1964 so you can appreciate how full of joy and gratitude I was. I served at SPN with Fr. Gerry MacAulay and Fr. Louis Lamb until June of 1977 when Archbishop Quinn appointed me to St. Charles Borromeo just before he left to become the Archbishop of San Francisco. I served with Fr. Jim Kastner and Fr. Bill Ross and the wonderful people of St. Charles until my transfer to St. Mary's in Ponca City where I served with Fr. Ernie Flusche. Looking back now, precious memories of working with and for the priests and members of those parishes was a real joy. Thank you, Lord!

In June of 1981, Archbishop Salatka appointed me to my first post as a Pastor at Sacred Heart in Mangum and Our Lady of Guadalupe in Hollis. I was full of apprehension as this would be my first time to make my home in rural Oklahoma. I was raised in a big city after all and what did I know about life in such a remote region of the Sooner State? My five years of service there turned out to be some of the best years of my life.

While there we built the first ever parish hall and classrooms at Sacred Heart and a brand-new church and multi-purpose center at Hollis. There were lots of tears shed when I was transferred in 1986, but they were exciting days, and I can never be grateful enough for them.

Archbishop Salatka asked me to become the Pastor at St. Philip Neri in Midwest City to succeed Fr. Louis Lamb with whom I had served in the mid-seventies. I couldn't have been more excited and grateful to be able to return to serving the people of SPN. Though started in 1946, the parish had never built a dedicated church, but they had built a flourishing school and were worshipping in the space that was built as a gym. I knew that there were many people who longed for a "real" church and others who were content with worshipping in the only space they had known over the years. Between 1986 and 1990 there were numerous conversations about future parish development. To make a long story short, the necessary funds were raised, and the new parish church was dedicated in November of 1992 by Archbishop Salatka. O happy day! I had served 15 years at SPN (four as an associate and eleven as Pastor) and was looking forward to my celebrating my 25th anniversary when in May of 1997 Archbishop Beltran asked me to become the pastor at St. Andrew's. Surprise! It was hard to leave.

I have little space left to acknowledge my profound gratitude to the people at St. Andrew's for the 25 years we have served the Lord together. I hope many of you can join me in my 50th anniversary celebrations. By God's Grace and your generous stewardship, we have accomplished a lot. It has been an honor to have been your pastor for so long. Let us pray for each other always. Thank you, Lord, for the wonderful people of St. Andrew's!!!!!!




