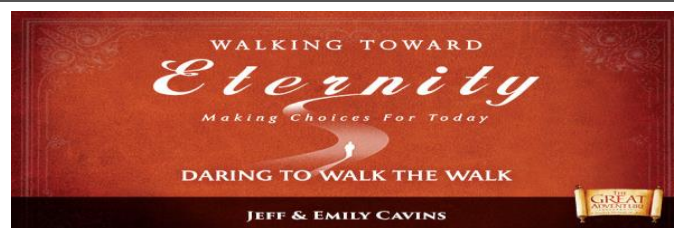

## St. Andrew Catholic Church FAMILY TAEKWONDO CENTER



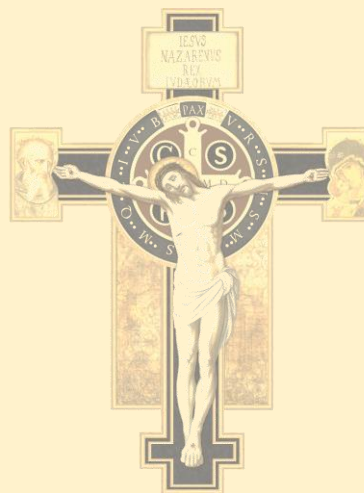
