

Hopefully you have received my letter and the pledge cards in the mail this week. Please review the pledge card carefully and then prayerfully make your commitment. This weekend we will hear from the architects, which will hopefully help everyone to understand the need for repairing and remodeling the church building insuring that our church will be here for many years to come.

### THE REPAIRS NEEDED

New roof and repair to roof structure: The beams holding the roof up are deteriorating. (see photos)

New walls: The outside walls which are currently underground, need to be repaired since the current roof is bearing down on them causing them to bow outward. The sealant that keeps water from coming into the walls has failed and need to be replaced. This includes removal of the berm around the entire building.

New foundation: Our Heat and Air vents run under the foundation. We often have water pooling in the vents because of rainwater runoff.

## THE REMODEL


Reconstruct the roof and structure of the building: Add additional space behind the sanctuary to provide adequate space for a new sacristy.

Removal of the berm: Allows us to change the look of the church. The walls will no longer be underground. We will add a new vestibule on the west side with a grand new entrance.

The foundation repairs: Will allow us to create a level floor and the addition of new air vents will ensure better air quality in the church.

I pray that you will join me in this building project to ensure the growth of our parish for years to come. My hope is that each household will make their best effort to pledge their part to make this happen.




