POLICIES AND GENERAL INFORMATION

A "Practicing Catholic" is a person who is making a good faith effort to live as a faithful follower of Christ throughout the week; and participates regularly in Sunday Eucharist. Practicing Catholics raise their children in the faith of the church after having them baptized within a few months of their birth. These are Catholics who have shortcomings and failings like anyone else, but who turn to God in prayer for help, and who frequent the sacrament of the Penance.

A practicing Catholic "in good standing" simply means that you are regularly attending Mass, You tithe to your home parish regularly by making the use of the parish "online giving" portal or through the use of parish envelopes, and lastly, that you strive to participate in the life of the parish by attending parish life functions or with volunteering service hours to the parish.

Holy Matrimony: There are few things more important than being well prepared for a life-long marriage in Christ. Practicing Catholic members of St Andrew's need to contact the parish office at least six months in advance of an anticipated wedding. If there has been a previous marriage of any kind, it may take as long as a year to make sure each party is free to marry in the Church. Couples who may be living together (for whatever reason) will be expected to do whatever is necessary to be in a state of grace on their wedding day. Two practicing Catholics are ordinarily married during a nuptial Mass. When one of the parties is not a practicing Catholic, the wedding is ordinarily celebrated without Mass or with Mass as requested.

Annulments are not "Catholic divorces". No one may even apply for an annulment until one year after a civil divorce decree has been granted. Christ's teaching about the indissolubility of marriage binds all whom God has joined together. Sadly, many couples enter what turn out to be self-willed unions. All marriages of Catholics and non-Catholics are presumed to be valid until proven otherwise. Previously divorced persons may not enter a valid marriage in the Catholic Church without first determining that they are free to marry. Those who do so are asked to refrain from receiving communion until their marriage is blessed in the church.

Demolition began indoors with stripping the carpet and sheetrock. The stained-glass windows were removed, the green tile taken down. Then the berm on the west side was taken down.


The excavator methodically took down parts of the church. Dug up concrete buttresses and has been loading all the debris into trucks which then take everything to the dump.


