A **"Practicing Catholic"** is a person who is making a good faith effort to live as a faithful follower of Christ throughout the week; and participates regularly in Sunday Eucharist. Practicing Catholics raise their children in the faith of the church after having them baptized within a few months of their birth. These are Catholics who have shortcomings and failings like anyone else, but who turn to God in prayer for help, and who frequent the sacrament of the Penance.

The Christian Initiation of Adults involves participation in our OCIA Program. Beginning in September, we normally meet on Wednesdays from 6-8:30pm. We serve a meal and childcare is available. For those who were baptized as Protestants, initiation consists of a Profession of Faith, Confirmation, and admission to Holy Communion. Those who have never been baptized celebrate the sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation, and Eucharist at Easter. You can begin OCIA at any point during the year by attending Mass regularly and making an inquiry to our Religious Education Director,

The Confirmation of young people is ordinarily celebrated for Baptized persons who have completed the fifth grade. The archbishop comes every year to confer this important sacrament on those who have been faithfully participating in religious education programs, who attend Mass each Sunday, and who have completed the Preparing for Confirmation. Participation in this program presumes that participants are seeking the grace of the Holy Spirit so they may more fully practice their Catholic faith. Preparation for First Penance and First Communion are two related but distinct programs for baptized children who are at least in the second grade. Church law requires that children ordinarily celebrate their first confession right after completing the Penance program and before beginning the First Communion Program. There are extraordinary circumstances under which a child who has not yet celebrated penance may be prepared for and receive their first communion, but only after consultation between parents and pastor. These programs are for children who have been and who will continue to be active participants in our religious education program, and who have been and will continue to be faithful participants in Sunday Mass. 

The Archdiocese of Oklahoma City through its programs, organizations and events, has numerous daily contacts with many children and young people. It is, therefore, important that all Archdiocesan Personnel, clergy, seminarians, religious, employees and volunteers, protect the rights of children and be alert to the possibility for child abuse.

Under Oklahoma State law, all individuals **MUST** report an incident or suspicion of sexual abuse of a minor (person under 18 years of age) to the civil authorities. The Oklahoma Department of Human Services has established a statewide abuse reporting hotline for reporting: **1-800-522-3511**. This number is available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. **If you feel the child is in immediate danger of harm, call 911.**

For the safety of children and the healing of victims, the Archdiocese of Oklahoma City provides an Abuse of Minors Pastoral Response Hotline for reporting the abuse of a minor (in the past or present) by a member of the clergy or other church personnel: **1-405-720-9878**. The Archdiocesan Victims Assistance Coordinator, a licensed professional counselor, will respond to calls to the Archdiocesan Pastoral Response Hotline.

A report to the archdiocese does not relieve the individual of the duty to report child abuse to civil authorities as required by Oklahoma State Law. In Oklahoma, failure to report child abuse is a misdemeanor punishable by law.

Safe Environment Training is required annually. Compliance expired for everybody on July 31 and renewal training must be completed by August 30 to become compliant for the upcoming year. The Safe and Sacred system will automatically send a reminder email to all existing users advising them of the need to renew their training. Please check your junk/spam box for this email from "Tech Support" if you don't see the email in your inbox.

Background check renewals occur every three years and are aligned with the training cycle. When a user is required to renew their background check, the system will automatically direct them to ISP (Integrated Screening Partners) to complete the renewal process when they log into the system. After completing the background check, the user will need to complete their annual training.

Update training is required by all catechists before classes begin.

To become a volunteer at St Andrew's, contact Ann Grover at agrover@standrewmoore.com, the St Andrew's safe environment facilitator, and she will provide instructions on becoming a volunteer and accessing the training portal. The requirements to become a volunteer include creating a user account in the Safe and Sacred system, submitting a criminal background check, submitting three references to the parish safe environment facilitator to be checked, submitting and adhering to all safe environment policies and completing a safe environment training course in the Safe and Sacred training portal.


