## SAFE ENVIRONMENT RENEWAL TRAINING

All Archdiocesan Personnel, clergy, seminarians, religious, employees and volunteers, are required to protect the rights of children and be alert to the possibility for child abuse.

Under Oklahoma State law, all individuals MUST report an incident or suspicion of sexual abuse of a minor (person under 18 years of age) to the civil authorities.

All personnel who are registered in the archdiocesan safe environment program are required to update their training annually.

**Safe Environment Training is required annually. Compliance expired for everybody on July 31 and renewal training must be completed by August 30 to become compliant for the upcoming year.** Background check renewals occur every three years and are aligned with the training cycle. When a user is required to renew their background check, the system will automatically direct them to ISP (Integrated Screening Partners) to complete the renewal process when they log into the system. After completing the background check, the user will need to complete their annual training.

**Update training is required by all catechists before classes begin**

The Safe and Sacred system automatically sent a reminder email to all existing users advising them of the need to renew their training. Please check your junk/spam box for this email from "Tech Support" if you don't see the email in your inbox. If you are in the system and can't find the email, contact Ann Grover.

To become a volunteer at St Andrew's, contact Ann Grover at [agrover@standrewmoore.com](mailto:agrover@standrewmoore.com), the St Andrew's safe environment facilitator, and she will provide instructions on becoming a volunteer and accessing the training portal. The requirements to become a volunteer include creating a user account in the Safe and Sacred system, submitting a criminal background check, submitting three references to the parish safe environment facilitator to be checked, submitting and adhering to all safe environment policies and completing a safe environment training course in the Safe and Sacred training portal.


