



# **GROCERY CARDS** - Contact Angie Wolper at 403-934-0468

Every one of us buys groceries for our households each week. **Please consider pre-paying for your groceries by purchasing Grocery Cards.** Co-op Grocery Cards can be used for groceries and gas. **For every \$100 Co-op Grocery Card the parish receives \$9.** 

For every \$100 Sobeys Grocery Card the parish receives \$6.

The average family spends \$500/month. If 300 families in the parish use the Gift Card program, we could see an average of \$2,000 going into the Building Fund per month or approximately \$25,000 annually.

#### Please mark your calendars

We ask that all parishioners put the following dates into their calendars, as they are dates of sports tournaments at Holy Cross Collegiate that will require us to again cancel the Saturday evening vigil Mass and move to two Sunday Masses:

- January 29 (Two Masses on Sunday, Jan 30)
- March 12 (Two Masses on Sunday, Mar 13)

We will host two Masses on Sunday morning at 9:00am (confession 8:30am) and 11:00am(confession 10:30am), and invite parishioners to attend the Mass time that best works with their needs. We apologize for the inconvenience that this causes for parishioners and families, but as we do not yet have a church of our own, and must share space with the local Catholic schools, this conflict is unavoidable.
