


In addition to the Fifth Sunday of Lent, Bishop McGrattan has asked we bolstering our support

Baptism:

Baptisms are set for the last Saturday of the month. Please call the Parish Office 2 months prior to your chosen date for more information about Registration and Baptism Preparation.

Marriage Preparation:

Please call or email the office to make an appointment with Fr. Tomy at least four months prior to your wedding date. Please do not finalize dates before speaking with the Pastor.

Reconciliation/Confession:

Confession is available on **Saturdays, from 4:15-4:45 pm** and **Sundays, from 9:15-9:45 am** in the Holy Cross Collegiate Foods Room. Confession is also available by appointment. Please contact the parish office.

First Reconciliation/Holy Communion:

First Reconciliation and First Holy Communion Sacramental Preparation classes will occur from **October 2022 to June 2023**. Registration for 2022-2023 will begin in September 2022.

Every one of us buys groceries for our households each week. Please consider pre-paying for your groceries by purchasing Grocery Cards. Co-op Grocery Cards can be used for groceries and gas.

For every \$100 Co-op Grocery Card the parish receives \$9. For every \$100 Sobeys Grocery Card the parish receives \$6.

The average family spends \$500/month. If 300 families in the parish use the Gift Card program, we could see an average of \$2,000 going into the Building Fund per month or approximately \$25,000 annually.
