



As we await the coming of the Christ Child this Advent season, we are reminded that we too are awaiting a decision to begin construction of our new Church Building.

We have made significant progress in 2022! The Building Committee has completed the design of our New Church. The video we were shown in October which is also on our website, is a close representation of our new church we will build soon. Fundraising efforts have also continued in 2022. We are progressing a revised Pledge Drive Plan that will hopefully secure the remaining capital funds required for us to receive Calgary Diocese approval to begin construction in 2023. A meeting with Bishop William McGrattan (in November 2022) revealed that he is impressed with all the work that is done and is ongoing. He made a request that we continue to promote "our beautiful vision for our New Church complex".

This advice is being implemented as we seek additional pledges toward our new church. We are meeting with potential donors in the next few months before hosting another meeting with Bishop McGrattan in early 2023. Our goal remains starting construction in 2023.

In the spirit of Advent, I ask for your prayers as we near this goal. We are reminded that we are also building up the "people of God" as we build our physical church building. We have come a long way! Our combined time, talent, and treasure is required if we are to reach the final step in this process. We know that God is with us as we seek to do His will and build our new church....

Thank you to everyone for donating to our Christmas decorating. Flowers will need to be picked up after mass on Sunday, January 1st.




#### Friday Masses
