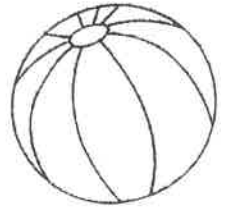


Dear Families,



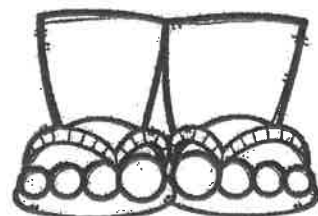

Summer is full of exciting adventures that students can draw and write about. I also included some writing prompts if they need an idea to journal about. Students can use the attached journal pages to journal in.

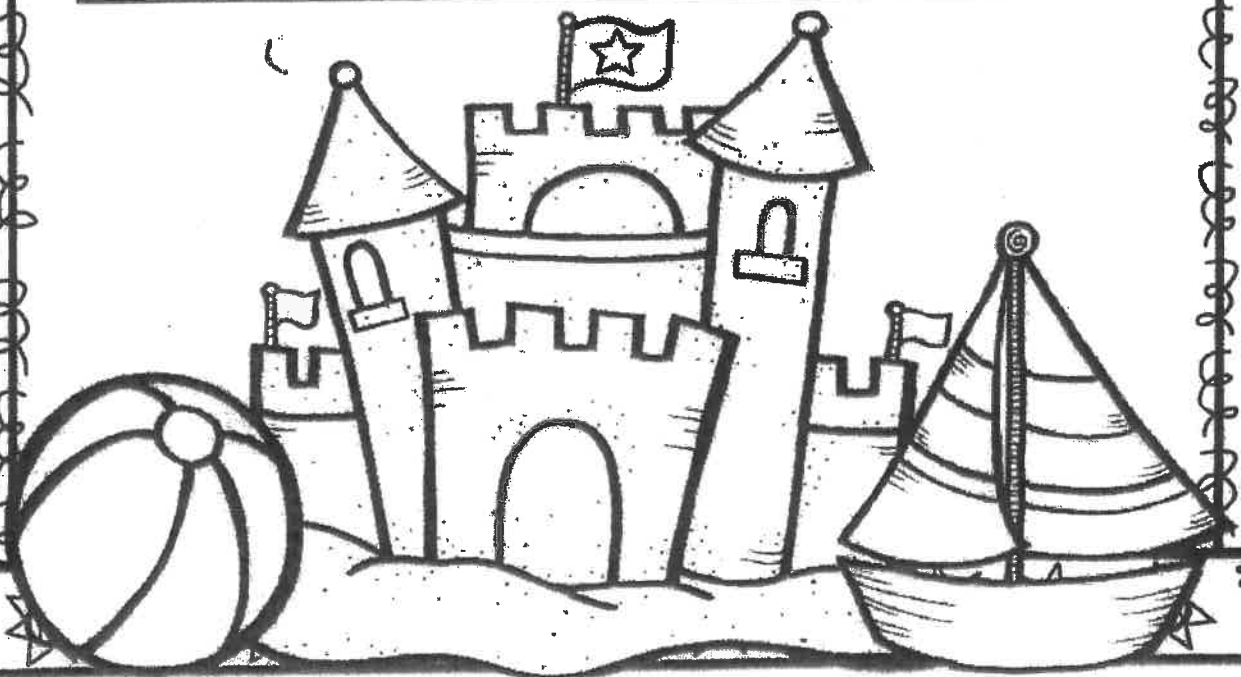
Help your child enjoy reading this summer! You can use the reading logs to track how many books you read and the summer reading chart to read various kinds of books in various kinds of ways!

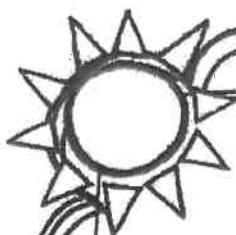

- What do you like to eat?

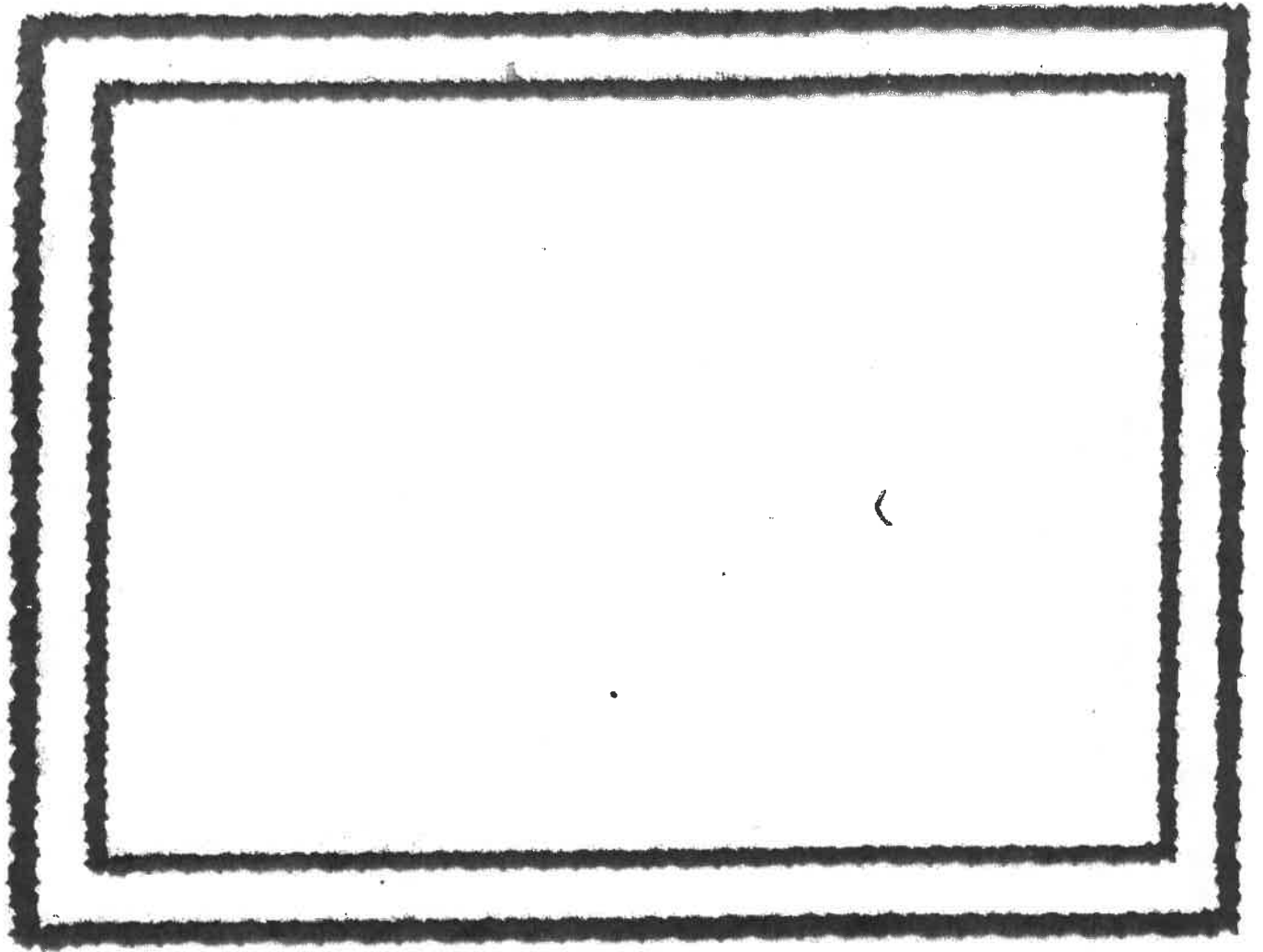




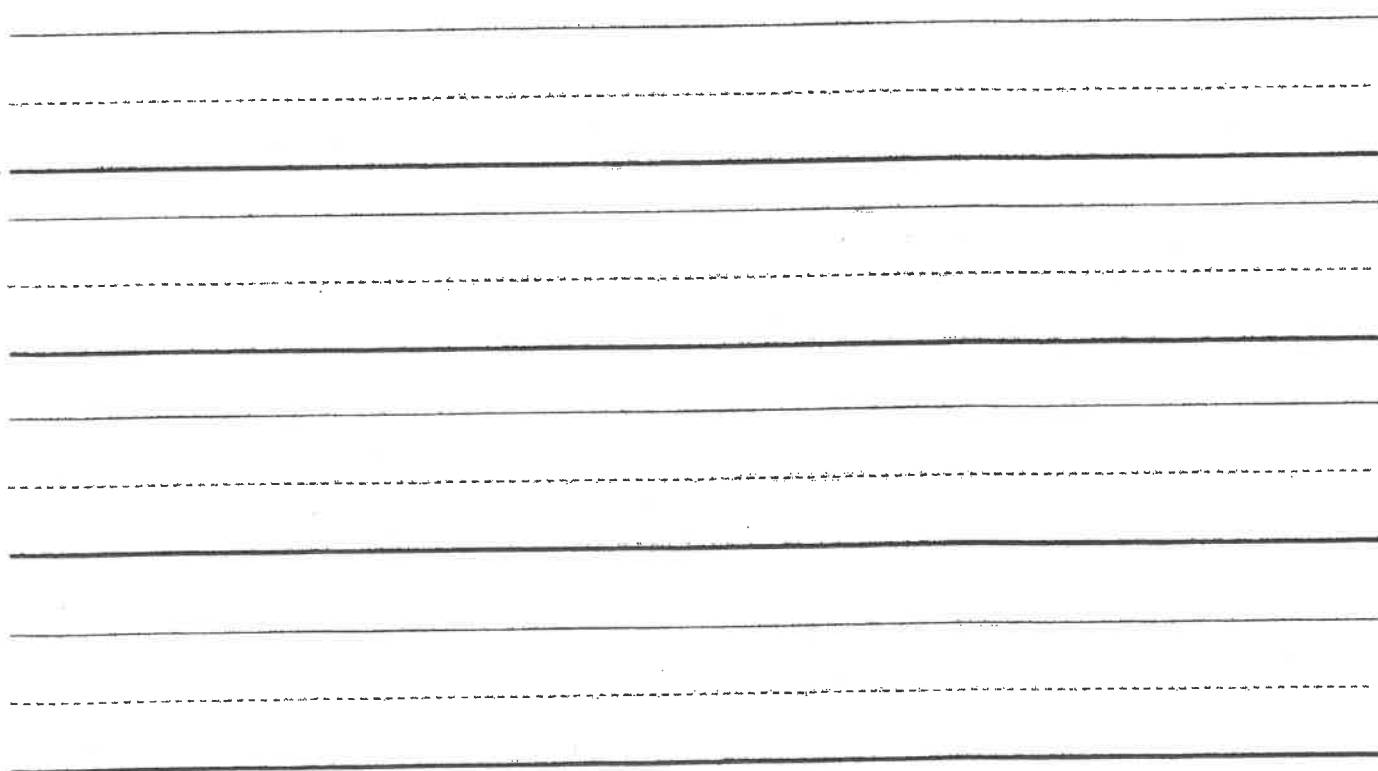
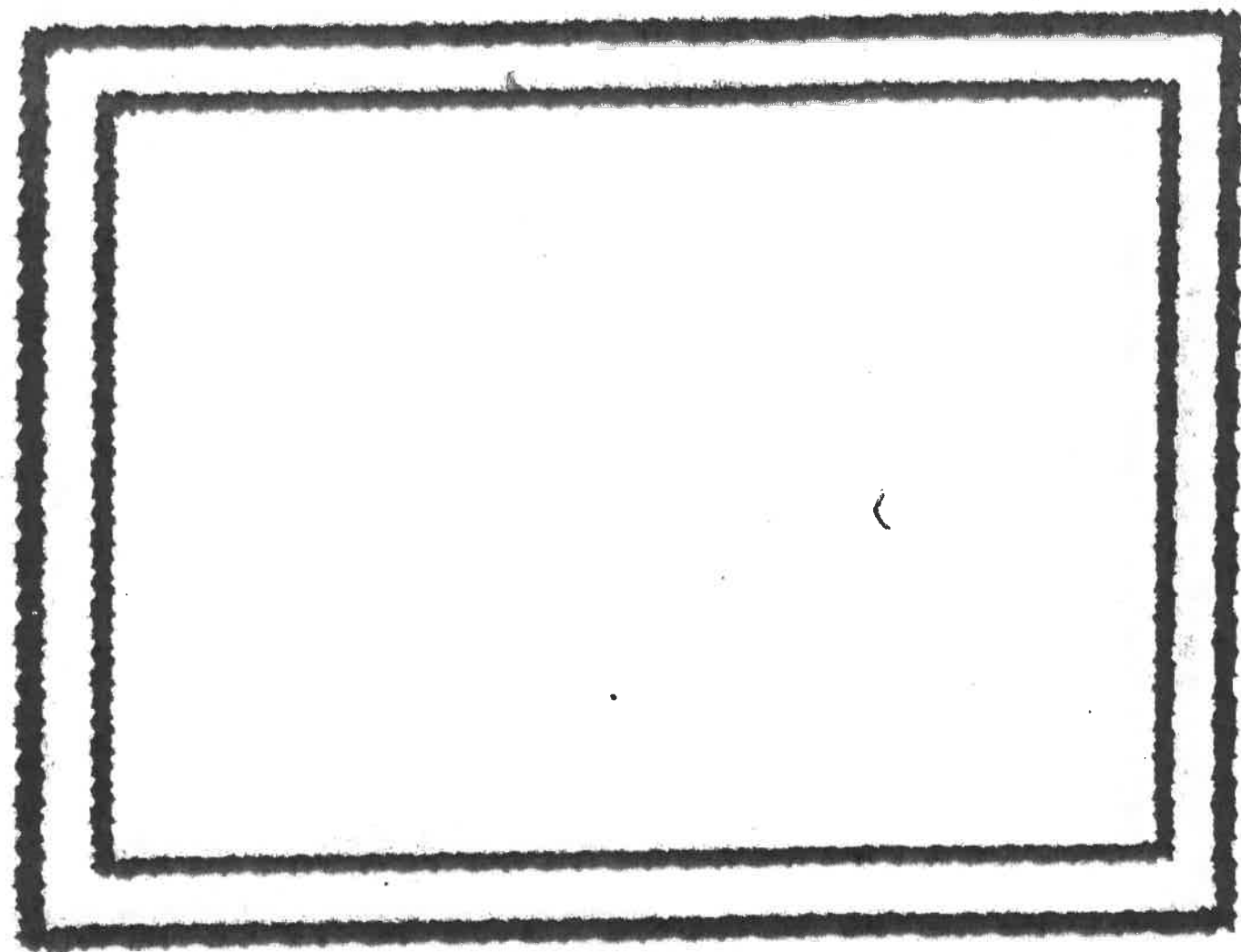


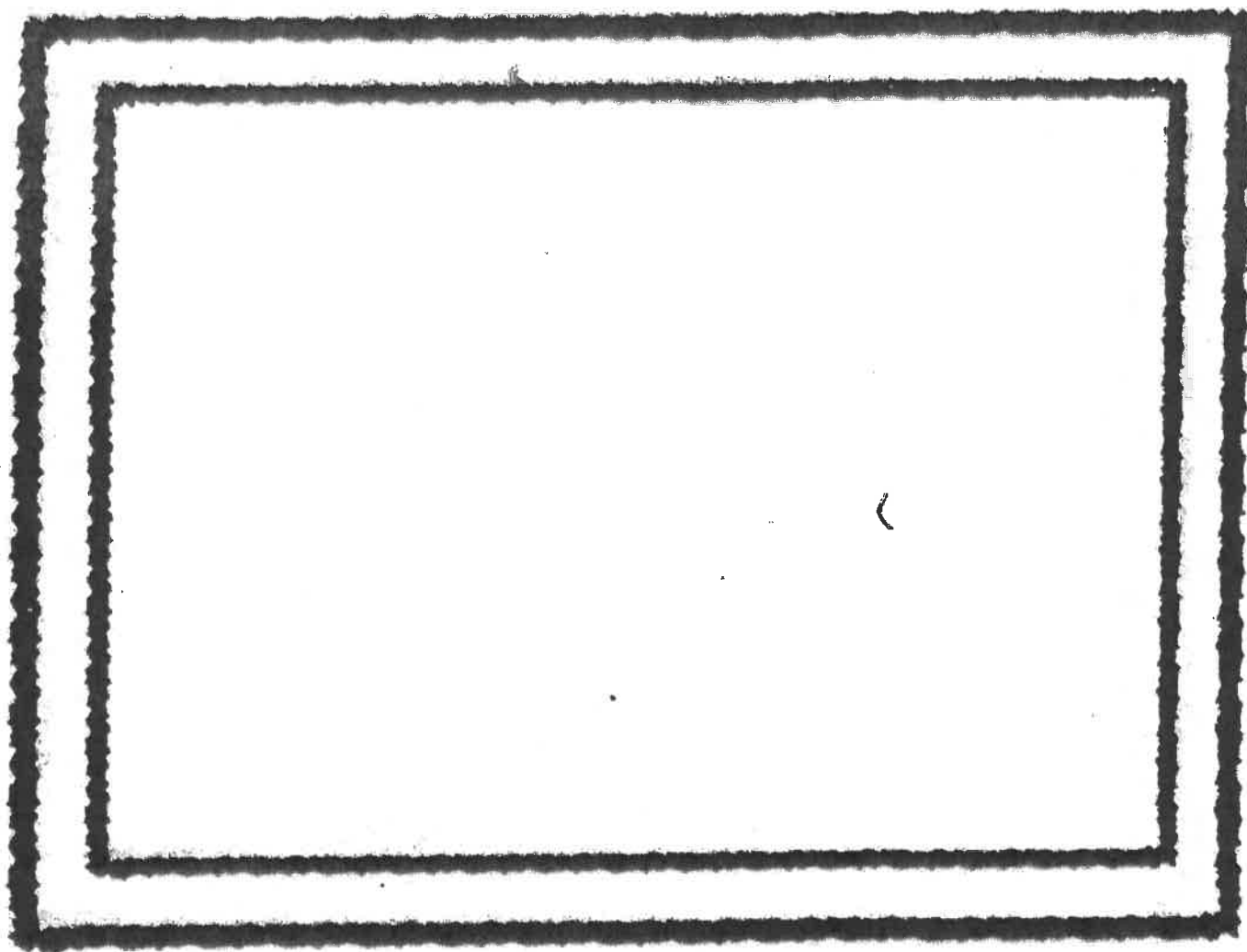
