

2022-2023 Tuition & Fees / Tuition Assistance

Tuition & General Fees

The Frassati Catholic High School Board of Trustees has set the tuition and general fees at \$18,950 per student for the 2022-2023 school year. The base tuition is \$17,950. The additional \$1,000 is comprised of the following fees: \$500 technology, \$300 registration/re-registration, and \$200 student activities. *Enrollment at Frassati Catholic High School is understood to be for the full year. Tuition is non-refundable except for specific circumstances outlined below.*

NEW for 2022. For returning families, only the 300/student re-registration deposit is due to retain your student's place in class if re-registration is complete by 4/6/22. The remaining tuition and fees will be due according to the payment plan you select.

For new families, a non-refundable \$700 deposit (=\$300 registration, \$400 tuition deposit) payment is due by 4/6/2022 to reserve your student's place in class.

PAYMENT OPTIONS

All remaining tuition and fees in either scenario is payable:

1. annually, due on July 1, 2022,

a. 2% Tuition discount if paid in full before June 10, 2022. (Not applicable if also receiving financial aid.)

- 2. semi-annually, due on July 1, 2022, and December 1, 2022,
- 3. ten (10) monthly payments, due on the first of each month from July 1, 2022, to April 1, 2023.

Fees - <u>All fees are non-refundable.</u>

There are some fees that are specific to a student's situation.

- An application fee is due at the time of application for a new student enrolling is \$75 (before December 15) or \$125 after December 15.
- Athletic & Fine Arts fees = \$175 per student/per sport or activity, due beginning of each season.
- A student parking permit is \$25 per student driver.
- An add/drop fee of \$100 fee will be charged for a schedule change not initiated by the school.
- Late pickup fee of \$10/minute for failure to pick up a student after school within the time set in Section V. of the parent/student handbook.
- Replacement of lost student agenda book or student access card = \$10.

Payment

Enrollment is completed through our School Admin Portal. All families must complete a Financial Contract and successfully pay their deposit of either \$300/student for returning families or \$700/student for new families to enroll for the 2022-2023 school year.

Blackbaud Tuition (formerly Smart) processes and collects tuition and most fees. Blackbaud's own enrollment fee is up to \$50 per family depending on the plan you enroll in. A convenience fee is added by Blackbaud to any credit and debit card payments. Late charges, NSF, and follow-up fees are each \$40 and are deducted from your payments before tuition payments. It is the policy of the Board of Trustees that all financial obligations to the school must be kept current for the student to continue at Frassati Catholic High School, reenroll for future years, or for documents to be released (grades, transcripts, and online access to grades).

Student Withdrawals

If a student withdraws from Frassati Catholic High School, a partial tuition refund will be granted only at the school's discretion in the case of (a) a student's extended illness, (b) a military or job transfer of the student's family from the Houston area, or (c) withdrawals requested by Frassati Catholic High School. The tuition in these limited circumstances will be prorated by the number of days remaining in the academic year at the time of withdrawal less 25% for any remaining time.

Tuition balance refunds for withdrawals other than the reasons listed above will not be granted. Frassati Catholic High School reserves the right to enforce collection of any unpaid tuition and/or fees and reserves the right whether to waive outstanding or future payment balances. A student's account must be current before reenrollment and before records and transcripts will be released.

Tuition Assistance

The tuition assistance program at Frassati Catholic High School provides financial assistance to students based on a family's demonstrated financial need. The determination of need is based on a standard application process that requires applicants to submit specific financial data through Smart Aid who provides Frassati Catholic with objective information regarding a family's financial need. Blackbaud Financial Aid application form may be completed online at https://financialaid.blackbaud.school/#!/login and is due by Jan 31, 2023. Frassati Catholic's school code is 12843.

The goal for offering tuition assistance is that no student be deterred from applying to Frassati Catholic because of financial reasons. Parents who anticipate a need for tuition assistance are encouraged to apply for aid on behalf of their child.

A financial assistance award is valid for the year indicated on the award letter, and awards may or may not be renewed subject to the parents' submission of an annual financial statements and the students maintaining sound academic and high citizenship standards that are expected. Funds are not reserved for families who do not follow the standard tuition assistance application process or who do not meet the stated deadlines. Should a family receive an external scholarship, award or financial aid from an external source, their award from Frassati Catholic High School will be reduced proportionally.

Tuition assistance and admission decisions are made separately from and independently of each other.

Frassati Catholic High School admits students without regard to race, color or national or ethnic origin in the administration of its admission and educational policies, tuition assistance programs, employment practices, and other school-administered programs.
