

Summer Reading 2025- World Literature

In preparation for World Literature you must complete these 3 assignments over the Summer:

I. Complete a Rough Draft of your College Essay

Complete a typed draft of your personal essay for college applications. Bring your typed essay with you to the first day of classes. This is a graded assignment worth 50 points.

2. Confessions by St. Augustine

Read and annotate <u>Confessions</u> (ISBN: 9780375700217). You will have a test on this during the first weeks of school. Bring your annotated copy of the <u>correct edition (see ISBN above)</u> on the first day. The annotations are a graded assignment worth 25 points. A major assessment on this text will be worth 50 points.

3. Pier Giorgio Frassati's Letters to His Friends and Family.

Read Pier Giorgio Frassati's <u>Letters to His Friends and Family</u>. Then write an essay about the three letters you consider the most interesting. In your essay make a claim about some truth revealed in these letters, a truth all three letters share. Be insightful, be bold. No 1st person or 2nd person, no passive-voice verbs, maintain verb tense. Do not go under 500 words or over 750 words. This assignment is due in the first weeks. *This is a graded assignment worth 50 points*.
