General Notes

- Organization is one of the keys to daily sanity and academic success, so more is not better.
- Simplicity and order will be a tremendous help to you.
- You may want to buy larger quantities than are listed above but keep the extras at home or in your locker so that you can replenish what you carry to class as needed. Only carry to class what you need.

Shared School Supplies
