Course Selections

To schedule classes, incoming freshmen and transfer students must rank their electives on the Course Selection Form provided in your Welcome Night folder. Keyboarding Prerequisite

Frassati Catholic requires all new students to pass a keyboarding proficiency test by the end of the first semester. Details about the program and testing are in your folder and are posted on our website on the Documents & Supplies page.

Physicals

All students ***new*** to Frassati Catholic are required to get a physical prior to their first day of classes. In addition, any student who plans to participate in summer sports practices, training, or tryouts must have his or her physical completed and turned in before starting those activities. On Monday, May 18, from 3:15 – 5:30 pm, physicians from Memorial Hermann will be in the Frassati Catholic gym to do physicals for the new school year. Please complete and sign your Medical History Form prior to coming. Bring your Medical History Form and Physical Examination Form (a double-sided form in your information packet) to the Student Life Building (enter through front doors) on May 18 between 3:15 and 5:30 pm. The cost for the physical is \$25 and can be paid with cash, card, or checks (made out to FCHS). **Please upload the completed physical form (both sides) to the FACTS portal.**
