Essential Questions to ask students:	What do you think will happen next? Why do you think the character did that? Who were the characters in the book? Where did the story take place? What happened in the beginning/middle/end of the story?	What is the name of this coin? How much is it worth? Can you count on from 8, 12, etc.? Can you write your numbers 0-20?	What did you notice during your walk? How has nature changed from winter to spring? What is a map? What do maps tell us? What can we learn from a map?	What questions can you ask to learn more about your friends? Where can you sit comfortably to relax?	What was your Lenten Promise? How has your promise helped you grow closer to God?
