ADORATION OF THE BLESSED SACRAMENT:

This week, Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament will take place in the church on Monday, Tuesday, and Wednesday from 11 am to noon, and on Wednesday and Friday evenings from 6:30 to 7:30 pm. There is no Adoration on Thursday.

ORDINARY TIME: Apart from those seasons having their own distinctive character, there remain in the yearly cycle those weeks (33 or 34) that do not celebrate a specific mystery of Christ. Rather, especially on Sundays, they are devoted to the mystery of Christ in all its fullness. This period is known as Ordinary Time (General Norms, 43). Ordinary Time resumed when the Easter Season ended, on Monday, May 29th, the day following Pentecost.

SAINTS/WINDOWS: Pierre Toussaint, 30 June. Pierre Toussaint (1766-1853) was born a slave in Haiti (upper panel). Jean and Marie Berard brought him to New York City in 1787, where he became a hairdresser. He attended Mass daily. With Elizabeth Ann Seton, he founded one of New York City's first orphanages, and he helped raise funds for the city's first cathedral. In 1990, John Cardinal O'Connor moved his remains to the crypt beneath the high altar of St. Patrick's Cathedral (lower panel).

PASTOR'S PAGE

Last year, we resurrected the relationship with our sister parish in Haiti, Notre Dame de la Visitation. Around this time last year, Fr. Andre, the pastor, told me the best way we could help them was to send their 500 children to summer camp for \$3,300. OLVP gave over \$9,000. Praise God through you! We gave the extra money to the parish the rest of the year for special events and to fund part of the salaries of the teachers in their school. Please see the pictures from last year's camp in our Gathering Space this weekend. So many happy kids enjoying fun and food together in the summer! And, it would not have happened without your generosity, so thank you.

Fr. Andre has asked for our help again this year. We will have the same goals in terms of amount of children attending and the dollar amount. If we exceed \$3,300, we will give to Notre Dame for their needs the rest of the year. Thankfully, Fr Andre, his parishioners, and the children have remained safe amid the incredible danger and turbulence of the violent revolutions surrounding them.

You can give to the summer camp and to our sister parish in Haiti by leaving a donation in the collection basket at the baptismal pool this weekend and through our parish website (via Faith Direct on our home page). Another parish in Maryland, St. Bernadette's in Severn, has been giving to Notre Dame for years, providing them with food, clothing, and shelter. Our role is to support our sister parish with other needs that are personal or spiritual in nature.

Thank you very much in advance for your thoughtful and gracious gifts to our brothers and sisters in Haiti.
