New physical and dental examination and vaccine guidelines were issued by the Pennsylvania Department for all students effective August 2017. Please check the WCASD or the St. Max website for more specific information related to these new guidelines.

Please check with your health care provider to submit the below mandated information. We always suggest that you keep a copy for your own records as well.

Please note that for students entering 7th grade the Meningococcal immunization and the Tdap immunization are required prior to entry on the first day of the 2018-2019 school year.

Parents/guardians have <u>60 days</u> from school entry to provide private physical and dental examination report. Private examination reports will be accepted from 1 year prior to the start of the new school year.
