Please note that for students entering 7<sup>th</sup> grade the <u>Meningococcal immunization</u> and the <u>Tdap immunization</u> are required <u>prior</u> to entry on the first day of the new school year.

Private examination reports will be accepted from 1 year prior to the start of the new school year.
