Gaudete Sunday

Third Sunday of Advent

The Third Sunday of Advent is known as **Gaudete Sunday**, a day when the Church invites us to pause and rejoice. In the midst of Advent’s watchful waiting and quiet preparation, this Sunday bursts forth like a sudden beam of sunlight breaking through winter clouds. The rose candle on the Advent wreath reminds us that joy is not something we manufacture by our own effort—it is a gift that comes from knowing that the Lord is near.

In the Gospel today, we meet John the Baptist at a vulnerable moment. Imprisoned and facing uncertainty, he sends his disciples to Jesus with a startling question: “*Are you the one who is to come, or should we look for another?*” This is the same John who leapt in his mother’s womb at the sound of Mary’s voice, the same John who boldly proclaimed Jesus as the Lamb of God. Yet now, in the darkness of confinement, questions arise in his heart.

John’s honest doubt teaches us something important: **faith is not the absence of questions; faith is trusting Jesus enough to bring Him our questions.** And Jesus responds not with rebuke but with reassurance: “*Go and tell John what you hear and see.*” The blind regain their sight, the lame walk, lepers are cleansed, the deaf hear, the dead are raised, and the poor receive good news. Jesus points to the unmistakable signs of God’s Kingdom breaking into the world.

Advent invites us to do the same—to look again, to “hear and see” what God is doing right now. Sometimes we may feel like John, stuck in a place we did not choose, wrestling with delays, disappointments, or unanswered prayers. But Jesus whispers to us: *Look around. Grace is moving. Hope is rising. I am closer than you think.*

Gaudete Sunday reminds us that joy is not based on perfect circumstances but on the unshakable promise that **God is faithfully at work, even when we cannot see the full picture.** True Christian joy grows from trust—trust that Christ has entered our world, is present in our lives, and will come again in glory.

As we light the rose candle, let it kindle joy in our hearts. Let it remind us that even in difficult seasons, God is weaving something beautiful. Let us carry John’s honesty and Jesus’ reassurance into the week ahead. May we become people who recognize God’s presence, who cherish the signs of the Kingdom around us, and who share that joy with a world longing for hope.

Rejoice—the Lord is near!

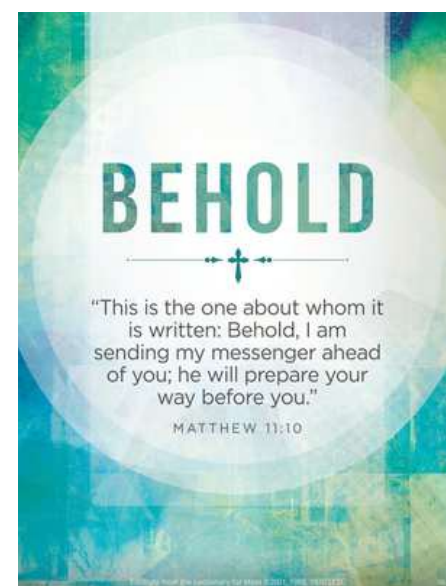
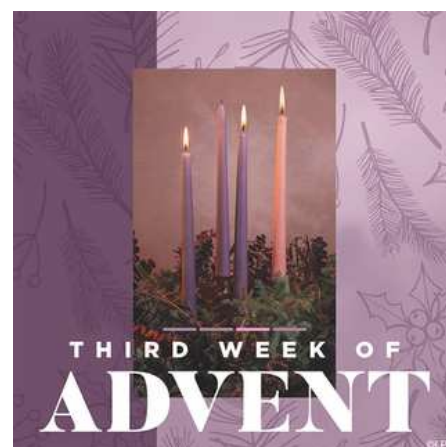
