LETTER FROM OUR ASSOCIATE PASTOR

"Put into practice what you have learned and received, what you have heard and seen in me ..." Flp 4,9

Dear friends!

We celebrated the first Sunday of October, consecrated to the Holy Rosary. This liturgical feast of Our Lady of the Rosary is celebrated annually on October 7th, the day of the Our Lady of the Rosary. It is a good opportunity and an invitation to pray the Holy Rosary as a community or as a family. In our parish, people pray the Holy Rosary every day before Holy Mass. The Holy Rosary on Sundays is prayed before the 8:30 am Mass. It can be done individually, following many of the versions that circulate on social networks.

Today, the 4th, is St. Francis' day. Pope Francis will launch an encyclical on universal brotherhood, "Brothers and Sisters", to remind us that we are one family. Regarding the coronavirus, the Pope has spoken on several occasions about the bonds of solidarity that unite all humanity and that have become more necessary in this difficult time of pandemic. We will reflect on the letter in the coming weeks.

Today's Gospel proposes the parable of the murderous winegrowers and is in continuity with the texts of the Gospel of Matthew that show the arguments of Jesus with the Jewish leaders before the passion. This complex text puts the end of a controversy that began in Galilee and will end with the crucifixion of the Lord. The parable is a preview of what Jesus will experience at the end of his life and a warning to his adversaries. Although the parable is taken from Mark (12,1-12), Matthew's version proposes some distinctions that bring the text to a density of greater controversy against those of the Jewish world who sought his death. Even so, the death of the winegrower's son is finally a fruitful seed for a new and definitive life. Good triumphs!

Christ Jesus must fill the present time, inspire belief and action, encourage prayer, and guarantee peace. In his "vineyard", which is the Church, the noble, just, pure, lovable, laudable must be cultivated; in a word, every virtue that springs from grace, in the footsteps of the supreme Master and Model.

As St. Paul says in his letter to the Philippians, the quality of the fruit of the vineyard must be seen in deeds, put "into practice" through joy, understanding, peace of heart and mind. In short, always do good. This is what the prophet Isaiah asks in the first reading of the people of Israel who are not faithful to the Lord's commission. The chosen people are the "vineyard of the Lord." Now it is fulfilled in Jesus and it is what St. Paul asks of the Christian community.

In October we have several important feasts. We begin today, October 4th, with the feast of St. Francis of Assisi. On Wednesday, the 7th, we celebrate Our Lady of the Rosary. Monday, the 12th, is the feast of the Virgin of Pilar and the day of commemoration of the arrival of Christopher Columbus in America and, with it, the arrival of the Gospel to this continent. Thursday, the 15th is the day of St. Teresa of Avila. On Sunday, the 18th, the Schoenstatt Movement celebrates its founding day.

We celebrated our fall festival this weekend. Thank you so much for your participation and cooperation! Despite the difficulties caused by the coronavirus and that it was carried out largely in virtual form, it was a success from every point of view: the sale of raffle tickets, baskets, prizes, t-shirts and food. The celebrations on Friday and Saturday were very well attended, despite limitations due to the pandemic.

May God, through the intercession of St. Paul, bless and remain with you!

CARTA DE NUESTRO ASOCIADO PASTOR

¡Queridos amigos!

Celebramos el primer domingo del mes de octubre, consagrado al Santo Rosario. Esto se debe principalmente al hecho de que la fiesta litúrgica de Nuestra Señora del Rosario se celebra anualmente el 7 de octubre, día de la Virgen del Rosario. Una buena oportunidad e invitación a rezar el Santo Rosario en comunidad o en familia. Aquí en la parroquia, se reza todos los días antes de la santa misa. O los domingos antes de la misa de 8:30 am. Se puede hacer en forma individual, siguiendo muchas de las versiones que circulan en las redes sociales.

Hoy, domingo 4, es el día de San Francisco. El Papa Francisco lanzará una encíclica sobre la fraternidad universal, "Hermanos y Hermanas", para recordarnos que formamos una sola gran familia. A propósito del coronavirus, el Papa ha hablado en varias ocasiones sobre los lazos de solidaridad que unen a toda la humanidad y que se han hecho más necesarios en este difícil tiempo de pandemia. Reflexionaremos sobre la carta en estas semanas.

El evangelio de hoy nos propone la parábola de los viñadores homicidas y está en continuidad con los textos del evangelio de Mateo que muestran las polémicas de Jesús con los dirigentes judíos antes de la pasión. Este texto complejo pone el punto final de una polémica que comenzó en Galilea y que terminará con la crucifixión del Señor. La parábola es un anticipo de lo que vivirá Jesús y una advertencia a sus adversarios. Aunque la parábola está tomada de Marcos (12,1-12), la versión de Mateo nos propone algunos matices que llevan el texto a una densidad de mayor polémica contra aquellos del mundo judío que buscaban su muerte. Así y todo, la muerte del hijo del viñador es finalmente semilla fecunda para una nueva y definitiva vida ¡El bien triunfa!

Cristo Jesús debe llenar el tiempo actual, inspirar el creer y el obrar, animar a la oración y garantizar la paz. En su viña, que es la Iglesia, se ha de cultivar lo noble, justo, puro, amable, laudable; en una palabra, toda virtud que brota de la gracia, tras las huellas del Maestro y Modelo supremo.

Como lo dice San Pablo en su carta a los Filipenses, la calidad del fruto de la viña debe verse en las obras, puesto "en práctica" a través de la alegría, la comprensión, la paz en el corazón y en la mente. En definitiva, hacer el bien siempre y en todo momento. Esto es lo que el profeta Isaías pide en la primera lectura al pueblo de Israel que no es fiel al encargo del Señor. El pueblo elegido es la "viña del Señor". Ahora se cumple en Jesús y es lo que San Pablo pide a la comunidad cristiana.

En octubre tenemos varias fiestas importantes. Comenzamos hoy 4 de octubre, con la fiesta de San Francisco de Asís. El miércoles 7 celebramos a la Virgen del Rosario. El lunes 12 es la fiesta de la Virgen del Pilar y día en que celebramos la llegada de Cristóbal Colón a América y, con él, la llegada del Evangelio a estas tierras americanas. El 15 es el día de Santa Teresa de Ávila. El Domingo 18 la familia de Schoenstatt celebra su día de fundación.

Celebramos el fin de semana pasado nuestro festival de otoño ¡Muchísimas gracias por la participación y cooperación! A pesar de las dificultades por el coronavirus y que se realizó en gran parte en forma virtual, fue un éxito desde todo punto de vista: la venta de las rifas, las canastas, los premios, camisetas y comida. Las celebraciones del viernes y sábado estuvieron muy concurridas, a pesar de las limitaciones por la pandemia.

Que Dios, por intercesión de san Pablo, los bendiga y acompañe!

27TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME 27º DOMINGO DEL TIEMPO ORDINARIO

The readings today challenge us to ask important questions about ourselves: What kind of tenants are we? Do we claim the vineyard of our lives for our own and turn God out or do we recognize that everything we have comes as gifts from God and is to be given back in praise? As we reflect on the gift of life and dignity given to each of us, how are we called to show greater respect for life: for the unborn; those on death row; the immigrants coming to our country with or without legal permission; enemies who kill others without regard? Where do we need to grow in love for the life and dignity of others?

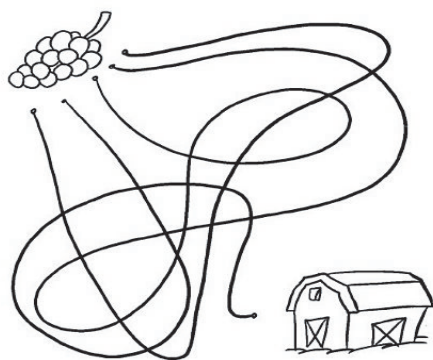
MONTH OF OCTOBER/EL MES DE OCTUBRE

This symbol of hope is the color of the sprouting seed and arouses in the faithful the hope of reaping the eternal harvest of heaven, especially the hope of a glorious resurrection. It is used in the offices and Masses of Ordinary Time.
