The Bar is Set Pretty High

Gosh, there is quite a challenge in this week's second reading from the Letter of Paul to the Ephesians (4.1-6): "Lead a life worthy of the calling to which you have been called, with all humility and gentleness, with patience, bearing with one another in love, making every effort to maintain the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace." This letter is a great recipe for life and fabulous material for a "Living Like Jesus" quiz. St. Paul is setting the bar pretty high. Check it out!


