Reflection ~ AJ Barrows

Jesus does not want us to be miserable. He wants us to be close.

So often as Catholics, we look at Lent as, "What can I give up or do to make these next 40 days tough?" or "What is the bare minimum I have to do to satisfy my Catholic guilt?" Let me ask honestly, how does giving up chocolate, Netflix, social media, etc. improve our relationship with God? Once the 40-ish days are over we know that we are going to go right back to what we gave up. If I gave up Netflix for a month to improve my relationship with my wife but then spent that time on Disney+ or complaining, it would be senseless. Nothing in our relationship would have improved, grown, or changed.

Relationships take effort and our relationship with Jesus is no different. So for this Lent, my encouragement is to commit to something, not to be miserable but something to practically improve our relationship with Jesus. It can still look like giving up chocolate, Netflix, social media, etc. Just make sure that the struggle is something that will improve, grow or positively change your relationship with Jesus.

My favourite suggestion for Lent is to drive at the speed limit for all 40 days (which, from personal experience, can be REALLY difficult). During the extra time we spend driving, we can intentionally give that time to Jesus in prayer, listening to Christian radio, or even offering Him our frustration at driving the speed limit. No time spent with Christ is ever wasted. He simply wants you to be close, not your misery.

Réflection ~ AJ Barrows

Jésus ne veut pas que nous soyons malheureux. Il veut que nous soyons proches.

En tant que catholiques, nous envisageons souvent le Carême en nous demandant : "Que puis-je abandonner ou faire pour rendre ces 40 prochains jours difficiles ?" ou "Quel est le strict minimum que je dois faire pour satisfaire ma culpabilité de catholique ?" Permettez-moi de vous demander honnêtement en quoi le fait de renoncer au chocolat, à Netflix, aux médias sociaux, etc. améliore notre relation avec Dieu ? Une fois les 40 jours écoulés, nous savons que nous allons revenir à ce que nous avons abandonné. Si je renonçais à Netflix pendant un mois pour améliorer ma relation avec ma femme, mais que je passais ensuite mon temps à regarder Disney+ ou à me plaindre, cela n'aurait aucun sens. Notre relation ne se serait pas améliorée, n'aurait pas grandi ou n'aurait pas changé. Les relations demandent des efforts et notre relation avec Jésus n'est pas différente. Pour ce Carême, je vous

encourage donc à vous engager à faire quelque chose, non pas pour être malheureux, mais pour améliorer concrètement notre relation avec Jésus. Cela peut prendre la forme d'un renoncement au chocolat, à Netflix, aux médias sociaux, etc. Assurez-vous simplement que la lutte est quelque chose qui améliorera, fera grandir ou changera positivement votre relation avec Jésus.

Ma suggestion préférée pour le Carême est de conduire à la limite de vitesse pendant les 40 jours (ce qui, d'après mon expérience personnelle, peut être VRAIMENT difficile). Pendant le temps supplémentaire que nous passons à conduire, nous pouvons intentionnellement donner ce temps à Jésus dans la prière, en écoutant la radio chrétienne, ou même en lui offrant notre frustration de conduire à la limite de vitesse. Le temps passé avec le Christ n'est jamais perdu. Il veut simplement que vous soyez proche, pas que vous soyez dans la misère.

Odbicie ~ Aj Barrows

Jezus nie chce, żebyśmy byli nieszczęśliwi. Chce, żebyśmy byli blisko.

Jako katolicy często w Wielki Poście stawiamy sobie pytanie: "Z czego mogę zrezygnować lub co zrobić, aby te następne 40 dni były wymagające?" lub "Jakie jest absolutne minimum, które muszę zrobić, aby zadośćuczynić mojemu katolickiemu poczuciu winy?" Zapytam szczerze, jak rezygnacja z czekolady, Netflixa, mMediów społecznościowych itp. poprawia naszą relację z Bogiem? Kiedy te 40 dni dobiegnie końca, wiemy, że wrócimy do tego, z czego zrezygnowaliśmy. Gdybym na miesiąc zrezygnował z Netflix, żeby poprawić relacje z żoną, a potem spędził ten czas na Disney+ lub narzekaniu, byłoby to bezsensowne. Nic w naszym związku nie uległoby poprawie, rozwinieciu sie ani zmianie.

Relacje wymagają wysiłku i nasza relacja z Jezusem nie jest inna. Dlatego też w okresie Wielkiego Postu zachęcam, aby się w coś zaangażować, a nie w być nieszczęśliwym, ale w coś, co praktycznie poprawi naszą relację z Jezusem. Nadal może to wyglądać jak rezygnacja z czekolady, Netflix, mediów społecznościowych itp. Upewnijmy się tylko, że walka będzie czymś, co poprawi, rozwinie lub pozytywnie zmieni Twoją relację z Jezusem.

Moją ulubioną sugestią na Wielki Post jest jazda z dozwoloną prędkością przez wszystkie 40 dni (co z własnego doświadczenia może być NAPRAWDĘ trudne). Dodatkowy czas, który spędzamy za kierownicą, możemy celowo poświęcić go Jezusowi na modlitwę, słuchanie chrześcijańskiego radia, a nawet ofiarowanie Mu naszej frustracji spowodowanej przekroczeniem prędkości. Żaden czas spędzony z Chrystusem nie jest nigdy stracony. On po prostu chce, żebyś był blisko, a nie twojego nieszczęścia.

Reflexión: AJ Barrows

Jesús no quiere que seamos miserables. Él quiere que estemos cerca.

Muy a menudo, como católicos, vemos la Cuaresma como: "¿Qué puedo renunciar o hacer para que estos próximos 40 días sean difíciles?" o "¿Cuál es el mínimo que tengo que hacer para satisfacer mi culpa católica?" Permítanme preguntar honestamente, ¿cómo es que renunciar al chocolate, Netflix, las redes sociales, etc. mejora nuestra relación con Dios? Una vez que pasen los 40 días, sabemos que vamos a volver a lo que dejamos. Si renunciara a Netflix durante un mes para mejorar mi relación con mi esposa, pero luego pasara ese tiempo en Disney+ o quejándome, no tendría sentido. Nada en nuestra relación habría mejorado, crecido o cambiado.

Las relaciones requieren esfuerzo y nuestra relación con Jesús no es diferente. Así que para esta Cuaresma, mi aliento es comprometernos con algo, no para ser miserables, sino con algo que mejore prácticamente nuestra relación con Jesús. Todavía puede parecer como renunciar al chocolate, Netflix, las redes sociales, etc. Solo asegúrate de que la lucha sea algo que mejore, crezca o cambie positivamente tu relación con Jesús.

Mi sugerencia favorita para la Cuaresma es conducir al límite de velocidad durante los 40 días (lo cual, por experiencia personal, puede ser REALMENTE difícil). Durante el tiempo extra que pasamos conduciendo, podemos darle intencionalmente ese tiempo a Jesús en oración, escuchando la radio cristiana o incluso ofreciéndole nuestra frustración por conducir el límite de velocidad. Ningún tiempo que se pasa con Cristo se pierde jamás. Él simplemente quiere que estés cerca, no tu miseria.



Our youth minister really wanted the Grade 8 Confirmation candidates to experience with joy the Sacrament of Confession. Not always a favourite part of Catholicism for many Catholic adults, it is a tall order to expect such from 13 year olds. But sometimes what we need is the concrete which came from our youth minister in the form of clay flower pots.

As he explained to the young people, a flowerpot can represent our heart. Just as a flower pot has a tiny hole in the bottom, so our heart has a hole from original sin. But it is still a good pot, and a good heart. With more sin, however, the pot becomes cracked, chipped, broken, smashed. Same with our heart. The grace afforded from the Sacrament of Confession restores this heart, puts the pot back together.

Add some somber, reflective music along with the smashing pots, and you have a wonderful visual. We were all amazed when the students were invited to come up for confession and we watched in awe as they all stood up en masse, heading to the lines towards the waiting priests.




