Reflection ~ Deacon David Kraemer

To paraphrase Peter's excitement in this holy, mountain-top moment: "Lord it is so good for us to be here! Can we hang onto this moment by building dwellings for you, Moses and Elijah?". Aren't we like that too with special, awe-inspiring moments, like when we see the Rocky Mountains, or the Grand Canyon, or Niagara Falls for the very first time? We grab our cameras and cell phones to take pictures that will capture the moment, and presumably also our breathtaking feelings.

Jesus' transfiguration, becoming radiant and his clothes dazzling white, gives us a glimpse of what we will be in our glorified state in heaven. But we don't have to wait until then to experience this radiance. We can place ourselves in the glory of Jesus when the priest elevates the Body and Blood of Christ during the Mass, or during Eucharistic Adoration. Of course, being in the light makes the spots of our flaws and sins much easier to see. We can either decide that we are too unworthy and fall back into the shadows to continue living in our darkness, or we can welcome the awareness of our spots and remove the stain of our sins in the sacrament of Reconciliation. With God's forgiveness, we too can savour the feeling of being spiritually clean and radiant. I also invite you to consider attending our Renewal Retreats on Apr. 20/21 (women) and May 4/5 (men). These will be mountaintop moments worth capturing.

Réflexion ~ Deacon David Kraemer

Pour paraphraser l'excitation de Pierre en ce moment sacré, au sommet de la montagne : "Seigneur, c'est si bon pour nous d'être ici ! Pouvons-nous nous accrocher à ce moment en construisant des habitations pour toi, Moïse et Élie ? Ne sommes-nous pas aussi comme cela lors de moments spéciaux et impressionnants, comme lorsque nous voyons les montagnes Rocheuses, le Grand Canyon ou les chutes du Niagara pour la toute première fois ? Nous saisissons nos appareils photo et nos téléphones portables pour prendre des photos qui captureront le moment, et probablement aussi nos sentiments à couper le souffle.

La transfiguration de Jésus, qui devient radieux et dont les vêtements sont d'une blancheur éblouissante, nous donne un aperçu de ce que nous serons dans notre état glorifié au ciel. Mais nous n'avons pas besoin d'attendre ce moment pour faire l'expérience de cet éclat. Nous pouvons nous placer dans la gloire de Jésus lorsque le prêtre élève le Corps et le Sang du Christ pendant la messe ou pendant l'adoration eucharistique. Bien sûr, le fait d'être dans la lumière rend les taches de nos défauts et de nos péchés beaucoup plus faciles à voir. Nous pouvons soit décider que nous sommes trop indignes et retomber dans l'ombre pour continuer à vivre dans nos ténèbres, soit accueillir la prise de conscience de nos taches et effacer la tache de nos péchés dans le sacrement de la réconciliation. Avec le pardon de Dieu, nous pouvons nous aussi savourer le sentiment d'être spirituellement propres et rayonnants. Je vous invite également à envisager de participer à nos retraites de renouveau les 20 et 21 avril (femmes) et les 4 et 5 mai (hommes). Ce seront des moments au sommet de la montagne qui méritent d'être immortalisés.

Odbicie ~ Deacon David Kraemer

Parafrazując ekscytację Piotra w tym szczególnym momencie na szczycie tej świętej góry: „Panie, jak dobrze, że tu jesteśmy! Czy możemy zatrzymać tę chwilę dla siebie, budując namioty dla Mojżeszu i Eliaszu?”. Czy my też nie zachowalibyśmy się podobnie w tak w wyjątkowej chwili, budzącej podziw. I tak na przykład; gdy po raz pierwszy widzimy Góry Skaliste, Wielki Kanion lub Wodospad Niagara? Chwytny za aparaty i telefony komórkowe, aby zrobić zdjęcia, które uwiecznią te chwile i prawdopodobnie także nasze zapierające dech w piersiach uczucia. Przemienienie Jezusa, w którym jego szaty stały się olśniewająco białe, daje nam wgląd w to, kim będziemy w naszym uwielbionym stanie w niebie. Ale nie musimy czekać do tego czasu, aby doświadczyć tego blasku. Możemy zanurzyć się w chwale Jezusa, gdy kapłan podnosi Ciało i Krew Chrystusa podczas Mszy św. czy też podczas Adoracji Eucharystycznej. Oczywiście przebywanie w świetle znacznie ułatwia dostrzeżenie w sobie wad i grzechów. Możemy albo zdecydować, że jesteśmy zbyt niegodni i wycofać się w cień, aby dalej żyć w ciemności, albo możemy przyjąć do świadomości obecność w nas wad i grzechów i zmasować je w sakramencie pojednania. Dzięki Bożemu przebaczeniu my także możemy delektować się poczuciem duchowej czystości i blasku. Zapraszam Was także do wzięcia udziału w naszych Rekolekcjach Odnowy w dniach 20/21 kwietnia (kobiety) i 4/5 maja (mężczyźni). Będą to chwile ze szczytów gór, które warto uwiecznić.

Reflexión: Deacon David Kraemer

Parafraseando la emoción de Pedro en este momento sagrado en la cima de la montaña: "¿Señor, qué bueno es para nosotros estar aquí! ¿Podemos aferrarnos a este momento construyendo moradas para ustedes, Moisés y Elías? ". ¿No somos así también con momentos especiales e impresionantes, como cuando vemos las Montañas Rocosas, o el Gran Cañón, o las Cataratas del Niágara por primera vez? Tomamos nuestras cámaras y teléfonos celulares para tomar fotos que capturen el momento y, presumiblemente, también nuestros sentimientos impresionantes.

La transfiguración de Jesús, volviéndose radiante y sus ropas deslumbrantes de un blanco, nos da una idea de lo que seremos en nuestro estado glorificado en el cielo. Pero no tenemos que esperar hasta entonces para experimentar este resplandor. Podemos ponernos en la gloria de Jesús cuando el sacerdote eleva el Cuerpo y la Sangre de Cristo durante la Misa, o durante la Adoración Eucarística. Por supuesto, estar en la luz hace que las manchas de nuestros defectos y pecados sean mucho más fáciles de ver. Podemos decidir que somos demasiado indignos y volver a caer en las sombras para seguir viviendo en nuestra oscuridad, o podemos dar la bienvenida a la conciencia de nuestras manchas y eliminar la mancha de nuestros pecados en el sacramento de la Reconciliación. Con el perdón de Dios, también nosotros podemos saborear la sensación de estar espiritualmente limpios y radiantes. También te invito a que consideres asistir a nuestros Retiros de Renovación el 20/21 de abril (mujeres) y el 4/5 de mayo (hombres). Estos serán momentos en la cima de la montaña que vale la pena capturar.
