Reflection ~ Deacon David Cummings ~ Diaconal Ministry Part 3 of 3 - Service of Liturgy

"...so he got up from the meal, took off his outer clothing, and wrapped a towel around his waist. After that, he poured water into a basin and began to wash his disciples' feet, drying them with the towel that was wrapped around him." [John 13:4-5] The most visible role of the deacon is that which he takes on within the liturgy. Interestingly, it is a role that is both, at the same time, not essential and totally essential! The deacon, in communion with his Bishop and the priests, cannot be properly understood outside of the context of Jesus' humble submission, he who "did not come to be served, but to serve..." [Mark 10:45] In his absence, all his liturgical duties are performed by others. Many of those duties he does have are very mundane - setting the table, cleaning up after the Eucharistic Meal, yet it is precisely that which sums up his ministry: God's presence in the minutia of our human existence. But in our celebrations, even if the Bishop himself was present, it is the deacon who proclaims the Good News! It is from his service to those in need that he proposes the Prayers of the Faithful, and calls forth the Community to live out its baptismal vocation in the world. "At the celebration of the liturgy, he reminds the whole Church of her diaconal mission to serve as Jesus did." [National Directory for the Ministry, Formation and Life of Permanent Deacons in Canada, CCCB Publications 2017; pp21-22]

Réflexion ~ Diacre David Cummings ~ Ministère diaconal Partie 3 de 3 - Service de la liturgie

« il se lève de table, dépose son vêtement, et prend un linge qu'il se noue à la ceinture ; puis il verse de l'eau dans un bassin. Alors il se mit à laver les pieds des disciples et à les essuyer avec le linge qu'il avait à la ceinture... » [Jean 13 :4-5] Le rôle le plus visible du diacre est celui qu'il assume dans la liturgie. Il est intéressant de noter que c'est un rôle qui est à la fois non essentiel et totalement essentiel ! Le diacre, en communion avec son évêque et les prêtres, ne peut être bien compris en dehors du contexte de l'humble soumission de Jésus, lui qui « ...n'est pas venu pour être servi, mais pour servir... » [Marc 10:45] En son absence, toutes ses tâches liturgiques sont accomplies par d'autres. Beaucoup de ces tâches sont très ordinaires - mettre la table, nettoyer après le repas eucharistique - mais c'est précisément ce qui résume son ministère : La présence de Dieu dans les petits détails de notre existence humaine. Mais dans nos célébrations, même si l'évêque lui-même était présent, c'est le diacre qui proclame la Bonne Nouvelle ! C'est à partir de son service auprès des plus démunis qu'il propose les prières des fidèles et qu'il appelle la communauté à vivre sa vocation baptismale dans le monde. « Lors de la célébration de la liturgie, il...rappelle à toute l'Église sa mission diaconal de servir à l'exemple de Jésus. » [Directoire national pour le ministère, la formation et la vie des diacres permanents au Canada, Éditions de la CECC 2017 ; pp21-22].

Odbicie ~ Diakon David Cummings ~ Posługa diakonańska, część 3 z 3 - Służba liturgiczna

„...wstał więc od posiłku, zdjął wierzchnie ubranie i opasał prześcieradło wokół bioder. Potem nalał wody do miednicy i zaczął myć nogi swoim uczniom, wycierając je prześcieradłem, którym był opasany”. [Jana 13:4-5] Najbardziej widoczną rolą diakona jest ta, którą pełni w liturgii. Co ciekawe, jest to rola jednocześnie nieistotna, ale całkowicie niezbędna! Diakona pozostającego w jedności ze swoim Biskupem i kapłanami nie można właściwie rozumieć poza kontekstem pokornego poddania się Jezusa, Tego, który „nie przyszedł, aby Mu służyło, ale aby służyć...” [Mk 10,45]. W jego nieobecności, wszystkie jego obowiązki liturgiczne pełnią inni. Wiele z tych obowiązków, które ma, są bardziej przyziemne - nakrywanie stołu, sprzątanie po posiłku eucharystycznym, ale to właśnie jest podsumowaniem jego posługi: obecność Boga w najdrobniejszych szczegółach naszego ludzkiego życia. Jednak podczas naszych celebracji, nawet jeśli sam biskup był obecny, to diakon czyta Ewangelię! Także w ramach swojej posługi potrzebującym to diakon odmawia Modlitwę Wiernych i wzywa Wspólnotę, aby żyła w świecie swoim powołaniem wypływającym z Sakramentu Chrztu św. „Podczas celebracji liturgii... przypomina całemu Kościołowi o jego diakonańskiej misji służenia na wzór Jezusa”. Reflexión: Diácono David Cummings ~ Ministerio Diaconal Parte 3 de 3 - Servicio de Liturgia

"... Así que se levantó de la comida, se quitó la ropa exterior y se envolvió una toalla alrededor de la cintura. Después de eso, echó agua en una vasija y comenzó a lavar los pies de sus discípulos, secándolos con la toalla que estaba envuelta en él". [Juan 13:4-5] El papel más visible del diácono es el que asume dentro de la liturgia. Curiosamente, es un papel que es, al mismo tiempo, no esencial y totalmente esencial. El diácono, en comunión con su Obispo y los sacerdotes, no puede entenderse propiamente fuera del contexto de la humilde sumisión de Jesús, que "no ha venido a ser servido, sino a servir..." [Marcos 10:45] En su ausencia, todos sus deberes litúrgicos son desempeñados por otros. Muchos de esos deberes que tiene son muy mundanos: poner la mesa, limpiar después de la Cena Eucarística, pero es precisamente eso lo que resume su ministerio: la presencia de Dios en las minucias de nuestra existencia humana. Pero en nuestras celebraciones, aunque el mismo ishop estuviera presente, es el diácono quien proclama la Buena Nueva. Es desde su servicio a los necesitados que propone las Oraciones de los Fieles y llama a la Comunidad a vivir su vocación bautismal en el mundo. "En la celebración de la liturgia, él... recuerda a toda la Iglesia su misión diaconal de servir como lo hizo Jesús". 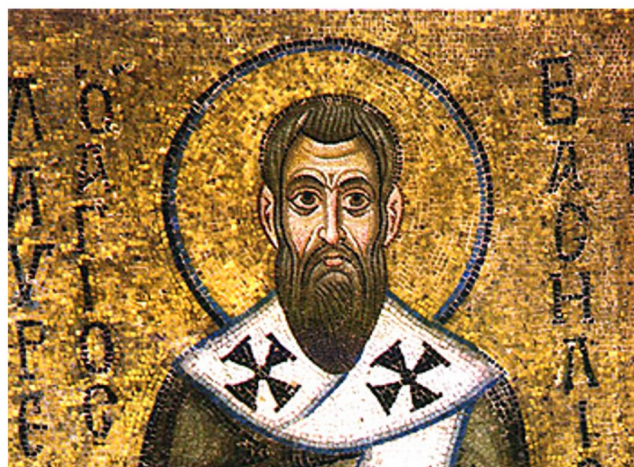

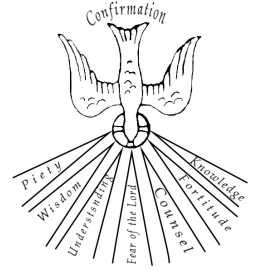

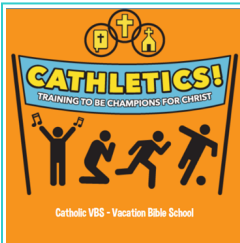

- Chair and Lead writer of the Synod Synthesis Team – Personal mandate to share her experience of the Synod and shaping the future of the Catholic Church.

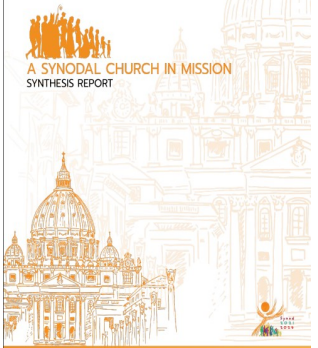
