Reflection ~ Fr. Joseph

Jesus said, "Let the little children come to me and do not stop them; for it is to such as these that the kingdom of God belongs." By this Jesus was teaching us a few things like the following.

- 1. Give children all the opportunities possible to be introduced to faith in Jesus Christ.
- 2.Be patient in your instruction of children realizing that seeds of the word of God will have great effects on their fertile minds.
- 3. Children need the special shepherding care of Jesus that is not intimidating or threatening. When Jesus welcomed the little children he told them they were important.
- 4.God uses the faith of parents as in today's gospel to catalyze the planting and nurturing of faith in their children.
- 5. Children shape their early opinions about Jesus by their initial experiences with him and his people. They need a person that they can see Jesus through. Allow children to experience your love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, gentleness and self-control.
- 6.Do not allow yourself to be discouraged by narrow-minded leaders like the disciples who thought the children were a low priority for Jesus. A child does not expect any person to be bad. They will make friends with a perfect stranger, and ask them to tie their shoe lace. The child has not yet learned to suspect the world. They still believe the best about others. That trust is a lovely thing.

Réflexion ~ Fr. Joseph

Jésus a dit : « Laissez venir à moi les petits enfants et ne les en empêchez pas, car c'est à ceux-là qu'appartient le royaume de Dieu. » Ce faisant, Jésus nous enseignait plusieurs choses, dont les suivantes.

- 1. Donnez aux enfants toutes les occasions possibles d'être initiés à la foi en Jésus-Christ.
- 2. Soyez patients dans l'instruction des enfants, sachant que les semences de la parole de Dieu auront de grands effets sur leur esprit fertile.
- 3.Les enfants ont besoin de l'attention particulière du berger Jésus, qui n'est ni intimidant ni menaçant. Lorsque Jésus a accueilli les petits enfants, il leur a dit qu'ils étaient importants.
- 4.Dieu utilise la foi des parents, comme dans l'évangile d'aujourd'hui, pour catalyser la plantation et l'entretien de la foi chez leurs enfants.
- 5.Les enfants se forgent leurs premières opinions sur Jésus en fonction de leurs premières expériences avec lui et son peuple. Ils ont besoin d'une personne à travers laquelle ils peuvent voir Jésus. Permettez aux enfants de faire l'expérience de votre amour, de votre joie, de votre paix, de votre patience, de votre bonté, de votre gentillesse et de votre maîtrise de soi.
- 6.Ne vous laissez pas décourager par des dirigeants étroits d'esprit comme les disciples qui pensaient que les enfants n'étaient pas une priorité pour Jésus. Un enfant ne s'attend pas à ce qu'une personne soit mauvaise. Il se liera d'amitié avec un parfait inconnu et lui demandera de faire ses lacets. L'enfant n'a pas encore appris à suspecter le monde. Il croit toujours en ce qu'il y a de meilleur chez les autres. Cette confiance est une belle chose.

Odbicie ~ Fr. Joseph

Jezus powiedział: "Pozwólcie dzieciom przychodzić do mnie i nie zabraniajcie im, bo do takich należy królestwo Boże". Jezus uczył nas w ten sposób kilku rzeczy, takich jak:

- 1. Dajcie dzieciom wszelkie możliwe okazje do poznania wiary w Jezusa Chrystusa.
- 2.Bądźcie cierpliwi w nauczaniu dzieci, zdając sobie sprawę, że nasiona słowa Bożego będą miały wielki wpływ na ich płodne umysły.
- 3. Dzieci potrzebują szczególnej opieki pasterskiej Jezusa, która nie jest zastraszająca ani groźna. Kiedy Jezus witał małe dzieci, powiedział im, że są ważne.
- 4.Bóg używa wiary rodziców, jak w dzisiejszej ewangelii, aby katalizować sadzenie i pielęgnowanie wiary u ich dzieci.
- 5. Dzieci kształtują swoje wczesne opinie o Jezusie poprzez swoje początkowe doświadczenia z Nim i Jego ludem. Potrzebują osoby, przez którą mogą zobaczyć Jezusa. Pozwól dzieciom doświadczyć twojej miłości, radości, pokoju, cierpliwości, życzliwości, dobroci, łagodności i samokontroli.
- 6.Nie pozwól, aby zniechęcili cię ograniczeni przywódcy, tacy jak uczniowie, którzy uważali, że dzieci są dla Jezusa mało ważne. Dziecko nie oczekuje, że ktoś będzie zły. Zaprzyjaźni się z zupełnie obcą osobą i poprosi ją o zawiązanie sznurowadła. Dziecko nie nauczyło się jeszcze podejrzewać świata. Nadal wierzy w to, co najlepsze w innych. To zaufanie jest czymś pięknym.

Reflexión ~ Fr. Joseph

Jesús dijo: "Dejad que los niños vengan a mí y no se lo impidáis; porque a los que son como ellos pertenece el reino de Dios". Con esto Jesús nos estaba enseñando algunas cosas como las siguientes.

- 1. Dé a los niños todas las oportunidades posibles para ser introducidos a la fe en Jesucristo.
- 2. Sé paciente en la instrucción de los niños, dándote cuenta de que las semillas de la palabra de Dios tendrán grandes efectos en sus mentes fértiles.
- 3. Los niños necesitan el cuidado especial del pastoreo de Jesús que no sea intimidante ni amenazante. Cuando Jesús recibió a los niños, les dijo que eran importantes.
- 4. Dios usa la fe de los padres, como en el evangelio de hoy, para catalizar la siembra y el fomento de la fe en sus hijos.
- 5. Los niños moldean sus opiniones tempranas acerca de Jesús por medio de sus experiencias iniciales con él y su pueblo. Necesitan una persona a través de la cual puedan ver a Jesús. Permita que los niños experimenten su amor, alegría, paz, paciencia, amabilidad, bondad, gentileza y dominio propio.
- 6. No permita que los líderes de mente estrecha como los discípulos que pensaban que los niños eran una prioridad baja para Jesús. Un niño no espera que ninguna persona sea mala. Se harán amigos de un perfecto desconocido y le pedirán que se ate el cordón de los zapatos. El niño aún no ha aprendido a sospechar del mundo. Todavía creen lo mejor de los demás. Esa confianza es algo hermoso.
