#### Reflection ~ Rev. Edward Okorie

What is Success?

According to our gospel reading this Sunday, James and John, the sons of Zebedee have probably learnt the lesson of their life. For them, and for many today, to be successful is to be boss of the lot. And success is measured in comparison between what one has accomplished in life and that of their "competitors". After all, the two brothers were fishermen who would probably work long hours, showing up before dawn so to reap the profit of their catch. And they had left all this to become close followers of Jesus.

That's why James and John went to Jesus, not just to ask for a place in the kingdom, but to be given a seat, "one on your right and one on your left". Jesus then went on to lecture the apostles on the real sense of success, for "you do not know what you are asking". For actually, God created every human being to succeed. No one was created by God to fail. But what are success and failure?

For Jesus, we succeed when we realize and fulfill the dream that God has for us. Contrary to what we usually think, Jesus tells us that not just anyone can become anything. And so, if we avoid James' and John's new age mentality of the anybody-can-become-anything type, co-operating with God's grace, we will realize God's dream for each of us. That's where true success lies.

Qu'est-ce que le succès?

Selon le texte de l'Évangile de ce dimanche, Jacques et Jean, les fils de Zébédée, ont probablement appris la leçon de leur vie. Pour eux, et pour beaucoup aujourd'hui, réussir, c'est être le chef du lot. Et le succès se mesure par comparaison entre ce que l'on a accompli dans la vie et ce qu'ont accompli ses « concurrents ». Après tout, les deux frères étaient des pêcheurs qui travaillaient probablement de longues heures, se présentant avant l'aube pour récolter le fruit de leur pêche. Et ils avaient quitté tout cela pour devenir de proches disciples de Jésus.

C'est pourquoi Jacques et Jean sont allés voir Jésus, non seulement pour lui demander une place dans le royaume, mais aussi pour qu'il leur donne un siège, « l'un à ta droite et l'autre à ta gauche ». Jésus a ensuite donné aux apôtres un cours sur le véritable sens du succès, car « vous ne savez pas ce que vous demandez ». En effet, Dieu a créé chaque être humain pour qu'il réussisse. Personne n'a été créé par Dieu pour échouer. Mais qu'est-ce que le succès et l'échec?

Pour Jésus, nous réussissons lorsque nous réalisons le rêve que Dieu a pour nous. Contrairement à ce que nous pensons habituellement, Jésus nous dit que n'importe qui ne peut pas devenir n'importe quoi. Ainsi, si nous évitons la mentalité « new âge » de Jacques et Jean du type « n'importe qui-peut-devenir-n 'importe-quoi », en coopérant avec la grâce de Dieu, nous réaliserons le rêve de Dieu pour chacun d'entre nous. C'est là que réside le véritable succès.

Czym jest sukces?

Zgodnie z naszą niedzielną Ewangelią Jakub i Jan, synowie Zebedeusza, prawdopodobnie wyciągnęli wnioski ze swojego życia. Dla nich, jak i dla wielu innych dzisiaj, sukces oznacza bycie szefem grupy. A sukces mierzy się porównaniem tego, co ktoś osiągnął w życiu, z tym, co osiągnęli jego "konkurenci". W końcu obaj bracia byli rybakami, którzy prawdopodobnie pracowali długie godziny, pojawiając się przed świtem, aby zebrać zyski ze swojego połowu. I porzucili to wszystko, aby zostać bliskimi naśladowcami Jezusa.

To, dlatego Jakub i Jan poszli do Jezusa, nie tylko po to, aby poprosić o miejsce w królestwie, ale aby otrzymać miejsce, "jedno po prawej i jedno po lewej stronie". Następnie Jezus wygłosił wykład dla apostołów na temat prawdziwego sensu sukcesu, ponieważ "nie wiecie, o co prosicie". W rzeczywistości Bóg stworzył każdego człowieka, aby odniósł sukces. Nikt nie został stworzony przez Boga, aby poniósł porażkę. Ale czym są sukces i porażka? Dla Jezusa odnosimy sukces, gdy realizujemy i spełniamy marzenie, które Bóg dla nas ma. Wbrew temu, co zazwyczaj myślimy, Jezus mówi nam, że nie każdy może stać się kimkolwiek. A zatem, jeśli unikniemy nowej mentalności Jakuba i Jana, typu każdy może stać się kimkolwiek, współpracując z łaską Bożą, zrealizujemy marzenie Boga dla każdego z nas. W tym tkwi prawdziwy sukces.




