The logo that was designed by the volunteer parishioners with the help of Scott Palko and his team at CCI Studios, represents our parishes well.

<u>The rising sun with 7 rays:</u> Our seven parishes coming together (Acts 2:3 - Divided tongues, as of fire, appeared among them, and a tongue rested on each of them.)

<u>The cross:</u> our salvation through Christ's sacrifice, redemption, and atonement. (Ephesians 2:15-17 - He has abolished the law with its commandments and ordinances, that he might create in himself one new Humanity in place of the two, thus making peace, and might reconcile both groups to God in one body through the cross, thus putting to death that hostility through it. So, he came and proclaimed peace to you who were far off and peace to those who were near.)

<u>The white dove:</u> The Holy Spirit (John 1:32 - And John testified, "I saw the Spirit descending from heaven like a dove, and it remained on him.)

### **Faith Formation**

#### **Mass Times**

The reduction in the number of priests serving our new Family necessitated adjusting the daily and weekend Mass schedules.

Church law and Diocesan norms limit the number of Masses that a priest should offer on a weekend. With the addition of weddings, funerals and school masses, our planning needed to be realistic and achievable from the beginning.

Attached is the current daily and weekend Mass schedule. The priests and the deacons will alternate between the seven locations for both preaching and presiding.

<u>Mass on Cogeco</u>: every Sunday at 12 NOON our Family of Parishes mass is televised on Cogeco channel.

#### Sacraments

**Funerals:** After your initial contact with the funeral home, please contact the parish office for Mass, service or internment preparation. Pre-planning is encouraged.

**Weddings:** The Roman Catholic Church asks that marriages take place in the sacred space of the church; that the couple has marriage preparation; and that the marriage be celebrated before the Church's representative. Please contact the parish office at least 9 months in advance before beginning to plan your wedding.

**Baptisms:** The restrictions brought about by the pandemic or other needs have altered our Baptism schedules. Please contact the parish office to make an appointment to have your child baptized.

First Confession, First Holy Communion & Confirmation: Dates for Sacramental preparation will be announced in the bulletin and on the website.

### Youth Ministry

With recommendations from the Youth Advisory Committee, our new Family has decided to hire a full time Youth Minister. The youth minister will work closely with our Lay Ecclesial Ministers, our 7 Catholic elementary schools and our 2 Catholic high schools. We hope to develop a vibrant ministry for our Youth.

#### Parish Pastoral Council and Finance Committee

Most members of the Transition Team have agreed to remain in place while a new Pastoral Council can be discerned to serve the Sarnia Bluewater Roman Catholic Family of Parishes. Their role, for the immediate future, will be to discern pastoral priorities and goals for the Family.

One or two parishioners from each parish will sit on the Parish Finance Committee. Their role will be twofold: to steward the resources of our Family and to find ways of funding the pastoral priorities and goals set by the Parish Pastoral Council.

The Sarnia Bluewater Roman Catholic Family of Parishes Finance Committee has agreed to a cost sharing on all items which will be used by our seven parishes. This cost sharing will also apply to new personnel being hired. This arrangement will be reviewed in six months after we have had time together as a family and better understanding.

Change is never easy and decisions are often made with the best information that we have at the time. We will be undertaking a survey of all parishioners in August/September and soon thereafter we will seek input to develop future plans for the Family.

All of us will be called upon to be patient and to be flexible. In the meantime, if you have thoughts or concerns that you would like considered, please bring them to any member of the Parish Pastoral Council.
