About the Cover - pictured on the bulletin cover is one of emblems found at the top of ten of St. Patrick's stained-glass windows that date from the 1880s. You can see eight of them in the church but two are found elsewhere in the parish museum "The Upper Room." There was a time when this room was used as a chapel for daily Mass. However, this image of the Sacred Heart of Jesus can be seen in church. June is the Month of the Sacred Heart and was celebrated as a solemnity on Friday, June 24, this year. The Sacred Heart of Jesus is a popular image to contemplate and write among Christian iconographers. The Heart, often seen as the seat of love, is portrayed as being on fire with love for us, topped with the cross where Christ out of love offered Himself for us, the Heart is entwined with the Crown of Thorns, and the pierced Heart pours out Blood and Water for our redemption. "In honoring the Sacred Heart, we are honoring the compassion and love of Christ, His human heart, moved with pity for this flock; His divine heart, pierced for the sins of His people. From the heart of Christ, pierced by the soldier's lance, blood and water poured out, 'the wellspring of the Church's Sacraments." Directly opposite this window is another window of the Immaculate Heart of Mary. More about that later.

Message from Fr. Hinterschied

The world was in a deplorable state at the end of the 5th Century AD. Morals, law, science and art all were in ruin. Christians were divided by heresy and throughout the whole Roman Empire there was no emperor, king, prince or ruler who was not a pagan, Arian, or Eutychian.

In the midst of darkness, one candle burned: St. Benedict, whose feast day is tomorrow, unwittingly was to regenerate the western world.

Benedict found this common denominator among all peoples: family. He recognized that the reform of morals and society must have a social approach, because it is a social problem. So he patterned the monastic life on family life and he patterned his family on the Gospels. The monks, under the Benedictine Rule, are a family, with the Abbot as father (cf. RB 2). The abbot is regarded as the representative of Christ. His spiritual sons worked with him for spiritual perfection. They produced by manual labor wealth which provided for themselves, and all surplus, for the poor.

The Rule is a minimum capable of being obeyed by all. Benedict makes no promises. He had no grandiose plans. He tells us frankly, he is writing a guide to sanctity for beginners. His whole life refutes the suggestion that he was conscious of any imprint he would leave.

He never put himself forward. He left no writings except the Rule. He never received the priesthood. Certainly, he never planned a school system, never planned to preserve the classics of antiquity, never planned to dot Europe with monasteries, never planned the conversion of a continent, never dreamed of his influence on institutions, nor the regeneration of the western world.

The divine reflection of success in his work is proof once again that God loves to build on nothing.


