About the Cover – Some time ago we pictured on the bulletin cover an emblem of a monstrance found at the top of one of our stained-glass windows that few have seen. Well now, you see its companion on the current cover of our bulletin. 114 years ago, you would have found this stained-glass window and its companion in the church itself. In 1909, St. Patrick's Church was extended and enlarged causing the two windows to be removed, but they were re-used elsewhere for the renovations. They are now in "The Upper Room," our parish's museum. At one time, this room over the sacristy was used as a chapel for daily Mass. This window on the cover and nine others similar in style were installed in the mid 1880s during the pastorate of Fr. William D. Hickey replacing plain glass windows. We still have all ten stained-glass windows.

This particular window depicts a chalice with a sheaf of wheat on the left and a branch of grapes on the right. The details are a bit fuzzy, not as sharp as they were 140 years ago (but what wouldn't be after 140 years!), but they remind us of the elements of bread and wine used in our celebration of Mass. It's interesting to note that the majority of the emblems in these ten windows are symbolic of the Eucharist.

Catholic Practices in Ordinary Time

The term "Ordinary Time" refers to "ordered or measured" time. It is time Christians reflect upon the teachings of Jesus and grow in the practice of their faith.

St. Jerome said, "Ignorance of Scripture is ignorance of Christ." Daily reading of Scripture is a fundamental part of a balanced Christian life. The lectionary is a good aide.

The soul needs good ideas to meditate upon. Jesus warned us about what we allow into our hearts. Fill your life with good thoughts. Readings from the lives of the Saints contain inspirational stories of living a virtuous life.

For those who are Internet friendly, Formed.org is worth viewing. Many Catholic websites contain a daily reflection. For those who do not use the Internet, there are many fine printed resources, such as Magnificat magazine.

FORMED.ORG: St. Patrick has a subscription to Formed.org. The website has a lot of inspirational videos on the Catholic Faith, the Saints, the Sacraments, etc. Father Pat recommends the Eucharist videos "Lectio: The Mass in the Scriptures." This powerful series will inspire you to take another look at The Eucharist and the Mass.

Altar Server Training - This is an important ministry in the Church's liturgy in assisting the priest and deacon at Mass and other services. Fifth grade or older Catholic boys and girls who are members of St. Patrick Church or are students at our school are invited to be trained for this ministry. Each server will need to attend two sessions - one for being the server during the Liturgy of the Word and the other session is at serving the Liturgy of the Eucharist. There will also be an additional make up session for those who missed one of the earlier trainings. Below are the dates and times for the sessions: Sunday, January 29, 9:00-10:00 a.m. - Training for the Liturgy of the Word. Sunday, February 5, 9:00-10:00 a.m. - Training for the Liturgy of the Eucharist. Sunday, February 12, 9:00-10:00 a.m. - Make up session. Once fully trained, the altar servers may serve at the Mass they are attending. If your child wishes to be trained as an altar server, please sign them up by calling the parish office at 740-852-0942, so that we may adequately prepare. Thank you.
