Guidelines for Lent

<u>Ash Wednesday and Good Friday</u> are the most important penitential days of the liturgical year. They are days of both fast and abstinence. All Fridays in Lent are days of abstinence.

The rule of fasting states that only one full meal a day can be taken. Two small meals sufficient to maintain strength, are allowed, but together they should not equal another full meal. Eating between meals breaks the fast, but drinking liquids does not. The rule of fasting obliges all Catholics from 18 to 59.

<u>Abstinence</u> refers to not eating meat on Fridays. The rule of abstinence binds all Catholics 14 years or older.
