She had smiles for the neighbors, though her husband found her religion and the charity it inspired annoying. She made tearful prayers in private for a son, outwardly self-assured but, as his mother knew, inwardly restless, and whose girlfriend of a dozen years had borne his child out of wedlock. Though not the first or last such mother and son, Monica and Augustine are the Church's most famous, so we keep their feast days back to back, with Monica's, fittingly, first. To Rome she followed Augustine, then to Milan, where years of prayer—and nagging—finally bore fruit in his conversion by Saint Ambrose. For six months, mother and son enjoyed the blessing of re-discovering each other. Just in time! On the way home to North Africa, Monica took sick and died near Rome. No child who has mourned a parent can read, unmoved, Augustine's tender account, in his *Confessions*, of Monica's last days. At this time of the year, when parents watch apprehensively as children leave for school, may Monica's perseverance and Augustine's long-prayed-for conversion ease anxiety and kindle hope.

When God Speaks

God has a funny way of catching our attention. It all started when I received a text from an unknown contact. The text read: "Who are you?" I don't typically respond to these, but for some strange reason I texted my full name - immediately regretting it. I then called the person to see if indeed it was a true friend and not some scammer. Yes, it turned out to be a friend who worked at a homeless shelter that has since closed and moved to another location far away. I was glad we had reconnected, and to discover that he had decided to stay on this side of town. We ended our conversation by saying that we would visit him some day during ministry. Fast forward two weeks, and Walt decided that the team would visit another friend - 86 year old Ms. Jackie, only to discover that her leased home was now abandoned and overgrown with tall weeds. She had mentioned to us in the past that she was not happy living there and wanted to move. We left concerned not knowing how we would ever reconnect with Ms. Jackie without a phone number, or new address information. Little did we know that God was already working behind the scene. We decided to move on and visit our friend who had texted me earlier. Again, having no address, but just a faint hint of the area we drove to the general location, and then called him to discover we were right in front of his new house! Not only that, as Walt turned and parked our car in front of another home...who do we see standing on her front porch? It was Ms. Jackie waving at us!! The team was absolutely amazed that God brought us to the very front steps of Ms. Jackie's new home! Who would have thought? Never in a million years could we have orchestrated this. I heard recently that we should never say we are in control, but I am certainly glad that God is. Matthew 10: 29-31 explains to us how valuable we are to God. "You can buy two sparrows for only a copper coin, yet not even one sparrow falls from its nest without the knowledge of your father. Aren't you worth much more to God than many sparrows? So don't worry. For your Father cares deeply about even the smallest detail of your life."

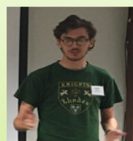

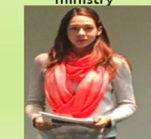

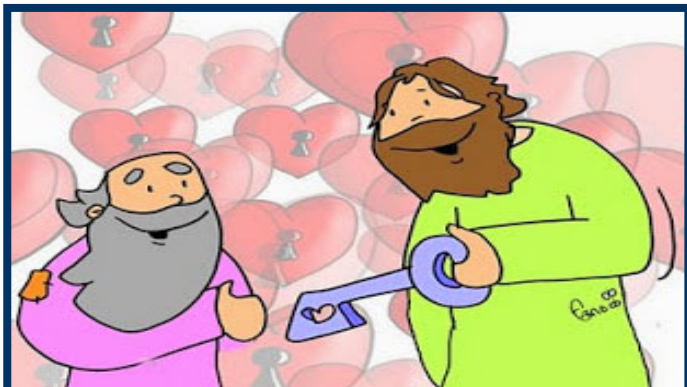

"SEÑOR, TU MISERICORDIA ES ETERNA, NO ABANDONES LA OBRA DE TUS MANOS"

TÚ ERES PEDRO, Y TE DARÉ LAS LLAVES DEL REINO DE LOS CIELOS



Mateo 16,13-20. Las Llaves.- Las lecturas de hoy, particularmente la primera y el evangelio, miran a las llaves, esos pequeños pero indispensables instrumentos que abren o cierran el paso. En tiempos bíblicos eran siempre de metal; hoy podríamos llamar llaves a las contraseñas que nos permiten acceder a un correo electrónico, o las tarjetas de crédito que usamos en los cajeros automáticos (ATM) o incluso a la forma y color característicos del propio iris, pero la idea es la misma. Hay una idea que se repite en nuestras lecturas de este domingo: "lo que él abra, nadie lo cerrará; lo que él cierre, nadie lo abrirá" dice el profeta Isaías refiriéndose al nuevo mayordomo del palacio real; Jesús por su parte le dice a Pedro: "todo lo que ates en la tierra quedará atado en el cielo, y todo lo que desates en la tierra quedará desatado en el cielo." Estas palabras del Señor, séanos permitido destacarlo, no fueron dichas a ninguna otra persona en ninguna otra circunstancia.

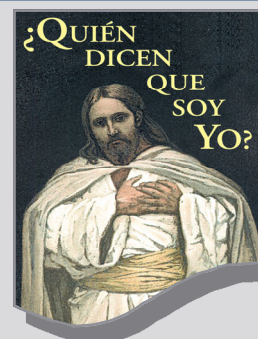
El (Controvertido) Ministerio de Pedro.- Por eso la Iglesia Católica habla de un "ministerio petrino," es decir, un encargo particular que Pedro ha recibido de Cristo y que en últimas constituye la esencia del ministerio que realiza el Papa, como sucesor de Pedro. Como se puede suponer, numerosas controversias han surgido entre los estudiosos de la Biblia sobre cómo se debe interpretar lo que el Señor dijo a Pedro. Los comentarios bíblicos clásicos de confesión protestante interpretan este pasaje de manera diversa. Para Robertson, el servicio de las llaves es el anuncio del Reino de Dios, pues a través de la predicación la gente entra al Reino, es decir, con ella Pedro "abre;" cuando la misma predicación muestra las exigencias de seguir el camino de Cristo algunos prefieren quedarse afuera, y en ese sentido Pedro "cierra." Según este modo de interpretar todo predicador hace lo que hace Pedro. Para Matthew Henry, otro protestante, las palabras de Pedro son expresión de la fe de todos los creyentes, de modo que lo que dice Cristo finalmente debe entenderse de la Iglesia entera, y no centrarse únicamente en una persona (y sus sucesores). En el mismo sentido va Albert Barnes, que añade con énfasis: "La única preeminencia de Pedro [sobre los demás apóstoles] fue el honor de abrir primero que ellos las puertas del Evangelio para el mundo." Para John Gill, protestante, las llaves indican la capacidad de explicar y anunciar la verdad del Evangelio. Las palabras de Cristo no dan autoridad "jurídica" sino únicamente proveen una capacidad para enseñar. De otro modo piensa el también protestante John Darby, que ve un poder para gobernar en la expresión que Jesús usa, aunque aclara que ese poder no reemplaza al del único Rey de Reyes, Cristo mismo. Sin embargo, Darby no relaciona este poder con el modo católico de entender el servicio del Papa.

El Poder de las Llaves.- No cabe duda de que son interesantes y defendibles muchas posturas de estos cristianos. Por lo pronto, nos ayudan a estar en guardia con respecto a todo lo que implica la palabra "poder" y su lugar en la Iglesia. Pero hay varias cosas que podemos anotar. Ante todo, ¿no es interesante que todas ellas vengan de los siglos posteriores a la Reforma Protestante? ¿No llama la atención que antes del siglo XVI nadie pensara que esa frase "se limitaba" a predicar y a enseñar? ¿No cabe suponer que ese modo de interpretar nació precisamente con un propósito, a saber, erosionar la postura católica y favorecer el estilo de ministerio protestante? Por ejemplo, san Agustín escribe: "La Iglesia ha recibido las llaves del Reino de los cielos, a fin de que se realice en ella la remisión de los pecados por la sangre de Cristo y la acción del Espíritu Santo. En esta Iglesia es donde revive el alma, que estaba muerta por los pecados, a fin de vivir con Cristo, cuya gracia nos ha salvado" (San Agustín, serm. 214, 11). San Juan Crisóstomo llega a más cuando afirma: "Los sacerdotes han recibido un poder que Dios no ha dado ni a los ángeles, ni a los arcángeles... Dios sanciona allá arriba todo lo que los sacerdotes hagan aquí abajo" (San Juan Crisóstomo, sac. 3, 5). Parece indudable entonces que debemos admirar y agradecer lo que Dios ha concedido a Pedro, y con la confirmación de Pedro, lo que ha concedido a sus sacerdotes. Concluyamos con la enseñanza de Juan Pablo II en su homilía del 29 de junio de 1998: "El Apóstol es el depositario de las llaves de un tesoro inestimable: el tesoro de la redención. Tesoro que trasciende ampliamente la dimensión temporal. Es el tesoro de la vida divina, de la vida eterna. Después de la resurrección, fue confiado definitivamente a Pedro y a los Apóstoles: "Recibid el Espíritu Santo. A quienes perdonéis los pecados, les quedan perdonados, a quienes se los retengáis, les quedan retenidos" (Jn 20, 22-23). Quien posee las llaves tiene la facultad y la responsabilidad de cerrar y abrir. Jesús habilita a Pedro y a los Apóstoles para que dispensen la gracia de la remisión de los pecados y abran definitivamente las puertas del reino de los cielos. Después de su muerte y resurrección, ellos comprenden bien la tarea que se les ha confiado y, con esa conciencia, se dirigen al mundo impulsados por el amor a su Maestro."

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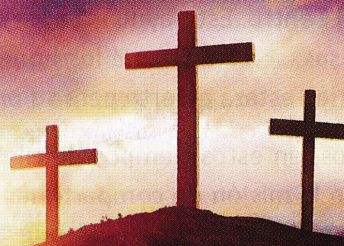
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
