

She's No Longer Here

I've written about Diane before. The last time we ran across her, she was at her usual spot — right at the front doorstep of a downtown bookstore. The bookstore owners were ok with the elderly homeless woman sleeping there. She was no threat to anyone. One of Diane's last statements to us was, "well by this time next Monday, you will no longer see me here. A spot in public housing has opened up for me", honestly I was delighted to hear this. And true to form the next time Walt was out ministering on the streets she was gone. A few homeless friends of hers shared with him that Diane is now off the streets, and in an apartment on the other side of town.

I was so thankful to hear this news because earlier this year while visiting her during the cold months we could see that she was battling a terrible cough and some flu like symptoms. The fact that she is now off the streets is truly a miracle. In the past two decades of ministering on the streets we've seen chronic homelessness first hand, and to put it lightly it ain't pretty! People are literally dying out there. So there is an urgency to remind them that God loves them and has not forgotten them. We do this by giving them a bag of groceries, warm clean clothing and toiletries, and praying with them.

I'm not saying that all that live on the streets are harmless, but I have discovered that God has his people in all walks of life, and yes even in the homeless population that do acknowledge Jesus as their Lord and Savior. So what are we going to do about this? Well I like what the Apostle Paul tells us in 1 Timothy 1:5, "The purpose of my instruction is that all believers would be filled with love that comes from a pure heart, a clear conscience, and genuine faith."

Let's love and reach out to others who could not possibly pay us in return. Like one of my favorite ministers of the gospel (my husband, Walt) says, "I know we can't do everything but we can do something."

**ÉSTE ES EL CORDERO DE DIOS,
QUE QUITA EL PECADO DEL MUNDO**



Juan 1,29-34. Te presento a Jesucristo.- Podemos interpretar el generoso amor de Juan Bautista en el evangelio de hoy como una manera de decir a cada uno de nosotros: "Te presento a Jesucristo." Muchos de nosotros cometemos un único error en la vida: creer que creemos. Nos imaginamos que ya sabemos quién es Jesucristo, que ya lo conocemos lo suficiente, que ya todo lo importante sobre él está dicho. Grave error de espantosas consecuencias: el que ya cree que sabe queda blindado para aprender. Otra lección de este domingo es que necesitamos que alguien nos presente a Jesús. De él dice proféticamente Isaías: "Tú eres mi siervo..." pues sólo en él se hizo realidad lo que significaba ese nombre de "Israel." De él dijo el Bautista: "Este es el Cordero de Dios, que quita el pecado del mundo." Necesitamos que nos presenten a Cristo porque a través de esa presentación llegamos a saber qué puede hacer por nosotros este Cristo que en cierto modo parece que nada pudiera. En efecto, las grandes virtudes y poderes del Señor Jesús están sobre todo en su Cruz.

Pero, ¿qué hay de valioso ahí? ¿De qué sirve ser coherente, leal, humilde, orante, puro? La Cruz parece inútil y el Crucificado parece un fracasado a menos que alguien nos ayude, nos predique y nos diga un día, que será el día más feliz de nuestra vida: "Te presento a Jesucristo."

¿Qué caracteriza a Jesucristo? Dispongámonos, pues, para conocer a Jesús. ¿Qué lo caracteriza? Dos cosas, según el evangelio de este domingo: él es el que quita el pecado y él es el ungido con el Espíritu Santo. Por eso precisamente lo llamamos "Cristo," porque como lo indica esa palabra en griego, él es el que está ungido ("crismado"). ¿Qué puedo esperar entonces de Cristo? Que quite mi pecado y que obre con el poder del Espíritu Santo en mi vida. Que quite el pecado de mi familia y obre con el poder del Espíritu Santo en ella. Que quite el pecado de mi país y obre con el poder del Espíritu Santo en él. Eso, y no menos que eso, espero de mi encuentro con el Hijo de Dios. ¿Cómo seré yo sin mi pecado? Seré mi verdadero "yo." El pecado ha vuelto de mi rostro una mentira, una caricatura en la que no puedo reconocer mi auténtico ser. Cuando Cristo quite mi pecado aparecerá la verdad de mi vida, con su esplendor, bondad y unidad. Al reconocerme en esa verdad sentiré gozo de existir y estaré reconciliado conmigo mismo: un paso maravilloso para ayudar a la unidad y reconciliación entre los demás seres humanos. ¿Qué hará el Espíritu Santo en mí? Hará maravillas. Todo el Nuevo Testamento cuenta qué clase de maravillas: ciegos que recuperan la vista, paralíticos sanados, gente excluida que vuelve a la dignidad y amor de sus hogares y patrias. Con el Espíritu Santo obrando en mí me sentiré amado y seré capaz de amar como nunca había amado.
