### Dear Church Family,

As we know God has always been intruding and interrupting our lives with new possibilities and bigger and better blessings. We need only to be open and accept this invitation and allow His will to be done in our lives. Today, the invitation is also an exhortation, as John the Baptist prepares the way of the Lord by preaching repentance and conversion.

True repentance is more than just telling God we are sorry and true conversion is more than a one-time encounter with God.

True repentance requires us to "bear fruit." True conversion requires us recommit ourselves on a daily basis in our prayer, celebration of the sacraments and stewardship.

Let me encourage you during this third week of Advent to experience both repentance and conversion:
